One of our club members, Bruce Baker, attended a course at Red Rocks Community College on "The Citizen and Deadly Force". It runs each Wednesday evening from September 14th through November 30th from 5:30 to 9:10 PM. The fee is \$111.50. It covers the entire aspect of the use of deadly force in our society and is one of the most comprehensive treatments of the subject anywhere. Bruce feels that it is a most excellent course. Flyers are at the club house.

The board of directors discussed the guest policy at their last board meeting and discussed the same subject with those members who were present at the last general meeting. An effort was made to establish a guest shooters fee but this was defeated as it is contrary to the term "guest" and because the membership possibly do not know the policy. The definition of a "guest" is one who is invited by a member to use the hospitality of the range. The hospitality is abused when the guest continues to use the range when he is in a position to join the club. This implies that if the guest is a resident within normal travel of the range, he may be a guest once or twice to "try out" the range. More than twice, and he is not a guest. A person outside normal travel range who is visiting a member can be considered a guest for more than two visits. However, common sense places a limit on this, also. Understanding the term "guest", the policy is:

1. Only one guest shooter on the firing line with the member at any time. If more than one guest is present, trade off so only one is on the firing line at a time.
2. The member is responsible for his guest to insure safety of all present at all times.
3. All range safety rules are always applicable at all times and will be adhered to.
