The legislature (both State and National) is at it again. Again they are trying to punish the gun instead of the criminal. About the only defense that the honest citizen has is to write letters. And letters must be written! Following is a few comments to make your letter writing easier and more effective:

1. Find out who to write to. The easy way is to look in the phone book under your county's county clerk. Call them, tell them where you live, and ask for the address of your legislators.

2. Write the letter. Be respectful, be brief, say exactly what you want them to do (do vote for a bill; don't vote for a bill; support the second amendment; etc.) in the first paragraph. In the second paragraph tell them why you want them to what you asked in the first paragraph. In the third paragraph tell them who you are (a father, an employee of whoever, a concerned citizen, etc.). In the last paragraph, briefly repeat what you want them to do.
3. Mail the letter. It is best to get as many people as you can find to write letters at the same time as you so that they all hit the legislator at the same time.
4. Keep on mailing letters. If the time is short before a vote is to be taken on some issue, call the legislator to tell them what you want them to do and that a letter will follow immediately.
