CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB Board of Directors Meeting

June 29, 1990 7:30 PM at the club house

Attendees: Bower, Towne, Bateman, Glasier, Marosy, Brenna, Crowle, Deems, Thrush, Peacock, Edwards, DeHerrera, and Schwartz.

1. The minutes were accepted as published in the last newsletter.
2. Howard Glasier reported a good work party where they cut the weeds but that they have a lot yet to do.
3. Dick Bower reported on the State three position on the ninth with twelve kids which is a 25 percent increase over last year.
4. Alan Deems said that he is still looking for ads for the newsletter.
5. Charles Peacock reported on the special committee on the range usage fees structure. The committee propose raising the fees \$5.00 the leagues and for the NRA sanctioned matches. A motion was made to accept the committee recommendations. An amendment was made to specify the leagues as Cherry Creek activities and to specify \$15 for the meeting room use and 50 percent for Hunter Education activities. The motion passed.
6. Alan Deems moved to exempt the Juniors from the fees schedule due to trying to obtain tax exempt status. Howard Glasier said that obtaining tax exempt status is virtually impossible.
7. ~~Charles Peacock moved to assess Central Division \$40 per night.~~
The motion passed.
8. Dick Bower asked whether the Juniors should pay a fee for the Thursday night activities. The answer was no.
9. Joe Edwards reported \$12,660.88 in the CD's and money market accounts and \$8,263.70 in the checking account. The second half property tax is coming up which will cost \$4,500. There are seventeen members who did not renew from last year. Ted Bateman will ask Ross Ryan to contact those who did not renew from last year to determine the reason that they did not renew.
10. Joe Edwards said that the club annual picnic will be on August 19th at Buffalo Creek and that plans are needed to organize the food. A suggestion was made to set a fee with reservations but to refund the fee for attendance. The shooting will probably be a fifty round DCM qualification course. No scopes are allowed.
11. Ted Bateman opened the discussion on proposed changes to the by-laws by reading Mrs. Crowle's letter and her recommendations. After a discussion, Ted asked for a committee and Chuck Towne, Howard Glasier, and Tom Thrush were named. Chuck Towne will check the minutes of past board meetings for topics to be reviewed. Chuck Peacock pointed out that the members are in the club to shoot and that the board is responsible for its operation. Fred Crowle said that he feels that the by-laws should be updated by the board and then the membership should be asked for input. Chuck Towne set July 19th for the committee meeting and asked that all input be presented to the committee prior to that date.

12. Howard Glasier said that he is getting the loan of some lights for the range for assessment. He will set them up on the 50 foot line.
13. Howard Glasier said that he still has a problem with the method of tracking work bond hours and the method of naming the work party members. The topic was discussed.
14. Ted Bateman discussed the first cut at the 1991 match dates and decided to approve those which were on the list for 1990 and wait until the August board meeting to approve the 1991 dates which will allow for membership input.
15. Chuck Towne reported on the NRA annual meeting.
16. Jim Brenna requested that the action shooters be put on the same pay base as the other shooting activities. The request was made into a motion which was seconded. Jim said that the remainder of the profit would go back to the shooters. The motion failed due to a lack of a majority. Chuck Towne moved to consider the question again and the motion passed.
17. A suggestion from the suggestion box was read which asked that the pin shooters be limited to the west bay. Jim Brenna will make an announcement at the pin matches to this end.
18. Jim Brenna submitted a plan for hinged metal bowling pin targets which will hang from the back stop. Jim requested that a set be made up for a trial. The request was made into a motion which passed.
19. Dick Bower reported receiving a letter from the DCM proposing they provide M-1 carbines and ammunition for the Juniors. Dick will ask the DCM to provide detailed information.

Significant complaints were received from the recent survey about too little prime time left open for casual shooting during the regular winter shooting season.

At the August Board Meeting held on July 27 the shooting schedule will be set for the coming year.

It is important that members interested in receiving more prime time attend the coming July membership meeting to make their wishes known.

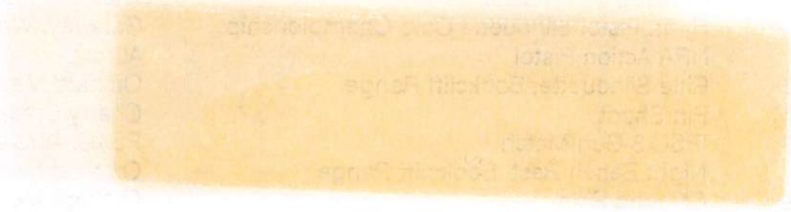
