1. The President, Don Shearer, called the meeting to order at 7:29 PM.
2. The minutes to the last general meeting were accepted as published in the newsletter.
3. Dave Goodlette reported that target carriers 13 and 16 have both been repaired.
4. Clark Calve reported that he is still holding one access card of a new member who has not taken the safety course.

5. George Wright said that the next tube certification course would be next Friday evening at 7 PM and to please sign up and also call him if you plan on attending.
 6. Warren Johnston announced that the next work party would be tomorrow at 8 AM.
 7. Don Shearer talked about the formation of the new club branch, the Cherry Creek Civic League. The new branch will be responsible for the Junior, handicapped and Boy Scout programs. The articles of incorporation have been filed with the state. The property tax exemption hearing has been delayed.
 8. Howard Glasier announced the names of those who are on the nominating committees list. The candidates are: Ron Burgy, Clark Calve, Bill Collins, Dave Goodlette, Lee Ormiston, Don Shearer, Tom Thrush, Gary Trisdale, and George Wright; all are incumbents. Also nominated are: Jim Bailey, Dave Epps, Brian Hunter, Norm Rose, Sandy Rudolph, and Cary Wood. The election will be during the December general meeting where members will vote for a maximum of thirteen new club directors.
 9. The President read the applications for new membership from seven new applicants. The applicants talked of their interest in the club and in shooting, their sponsors talked of the applicants merits, and they were accepted into the club by unanimous vote subject to the safety course and payment of fees. The new members are: Gene Danenhower, Alan Bieber, Nathan Berger, Chuck Hackey, Jerry Ramsey, Tony Stanley, and Trent Foster. All except Mr. Foster will have to take the safety course.
 10. Dave Epps said he will be accepting membership renewals starting at the December General meeting.
 11. The meeting was adjourned at 7:56 PM.

1. The board meeting was called to order by Vice President, Bill Collins at 7:30 PM.
2. The minutes to the last board meeting were approved as published in the newsletter.
3. Lee Ormiston reminded members to contact their Senators to ask them to vote for SB659. This is the bill to protect firearms manufacturers from frivolous law suits. HB1036 on the same subject has passed the house. Lee said to do nothing about the Clinton ban bill which will expire on 9-14-04. The club has received two rifles for the Scouts program. Four CCGC members are going to the rifle certification class tomorrow.
4. Clark Calve still is holding one access card from an old new member who needs to take the safety class.
5. Warren Johnston announced that the last work party for the year will be held December 13 at 8 AM.
6. George Wright asked to change the meeting time for the rifle tube qualification class to 6:30 until 10 PM because the Scouts meet at 7 PM. The Scouts will use the east range only.
7. Tom Thrush reported receiving a letter from Bob Lees but did not bring it with him.

8. Jim Nielsen reported on finances where the utilities are higher as the winter season and activities set in. The board discussed the range heaters. After being turned off, the heaters continue to run for their cool down cycle.
 9. Gary Trisdale reported that the Juniors are doing well and are still improving.
 10. Bill Collins reported that there are approximately 450 members.
 11. Gary Trisdale said that he will continue the recycle effort on the range brass.
 12. The board discussed the damage to the range overhead. It is still due to members carelessness in not realizing where their shots go after going through a target. Shooters, make sure your shots go into the backstop after passing through the target.
 13. Bill Collins read a letter from Don Shearer about the Wheeling \Sportsmen. The club needs more handicapped members and more help with the handicapped program. Don plans a second introductory meeting and suggested that classes be planned. A suggestion was made to spread out the introductory meetings. The board discussed the proposal to delete the work bond fee for the handicapped members and the initiation fee for the first six months from membership drive inception through June 2004. A motion to table the discussion failed. A motion to waive the initiation fee for the Wheeling Sportsmen and Outdoor Buddies clubs through the June general meeting passed unanimously. A motion to accept the recommendations listed in the Shearer letter passed unanimously.
 14. A letter to Don Shearer to donate the work bond refund to the Juniors and/or scouts was discussed.
 15. A letter from Tom Wallace to hold personal protection classes was discussed. Approval was given subject to the policy to tender ten percent of the class fees to the club and to limit classes by any one agency to once per three month period.
 16. The nominations for the 2004 Board of Directors was read. The nominees are: Jim Bailey, Ron Burgy, Clark Calve, Bill Collins, Dave Epps, Dave Goodlette, Brian Hunter, Lee Ormiston, Norm Rose, Sandy Rudolph, Don Shearer, Tom Thrush, Gary Trisdale, Cary Wood, and George Wright.
 17. The meeting was adjourned at 8:48 PM.
