BOY SCOUTS MARKSMANSHIP MERIT BADGE PROGRAM

Cherry Creek Gun Club (CCGC) hosted the first classroom/range session with members of the Boy Scouts of America (BSA) on August 22nd. Six scouts and three adult leaders of the organization showed up to kick off this new club sponsored program. After introductions were made, Mrs. Iona Baldock (Certified Range Officer and Rifle Instructor), Mr. Richard Smith (Certified Range Officer and Rifle Instructor) and Mr. David Adair (Certified Rifle Instructor) of the BSA gave the initial presentation covering NRA gun handling safety rules, range rules, shooting techniques and the importance of wearing eye and hear protection. CCGC range rules and other in-house guidelines were provided by club members.

Mr. Richard Smith was the designated Range Officer and the six scouts shot for the better part of two hours. CCGC members Bill Collins, Clark Calve, Lee Ormiston, George Wright, Gary Trisdale and Bill Bierbach assisted as coaches. Both Mrs. Baldock and Mr. Adair, of the BSA, also stayed for the range session and provided assistance where needed.

The BSA provided rifles (single-shot, bolt-action), for the evenings shooting. CCGC is in the process of purchasing some to be used specifically for this program. Hopefully, we'll have them in time for the next scheduled session on Sept. 19th. If not, the BSA folks have graciously agreed to make them available again.

After the range session was over, many of the Scouts and the adults with them thanked various CCGC members for making our facility available and for the active participation of those members who were present. Later, the CCGC members and the BSA adult leaders took the

time to discuss how the evenings session had gone. The consensus was things went very smooth for it being the first time in a "new" facility with a number of the people involved having just been exposed to a new program.

It should be noted that while a couple of the CCGC members who have offered to help with this program are NRA Certified Rifle Instructors that the rest are in various stages of attaining that rating. The goal is to create a pool of certified instructors that will make it possible to take over the leadership role in this endeavor so that it won't always be necessary for the BSA to provide the qualified personnel. - 1. The President, Don Shearer, called the meeting to order at 7:33PM.
- 2. The minutes to the last general meeting were accepted as published in the newsletter.
- 3. Bill Bierbach will have four members for a rifle certification class in preparation for the Boy Scouts first session on August 22. Bill also reported that he now has a full roster for janitors for the remainder of the year.
- 4. George Wright said that the next rifle tube class will be next Friday evening and to please sign up and call him for reservations. If you call and not show up, beware the wrath of George.
- 5. Gary Trisdale reported that one of the Junior ladies who started shooting last March, purchased a new rifle and used it to place first in class in prone.
- 6. Lee Ormiston said that the US Congress is on vacation but pro-gunners must still contact their congressmen to express their opinion. A case in point is the 1994 Clinton gun ban law which should be allowed to sunset. Lee mentioned the democrats abuse of judges during their hearings.
