Open (Adult) Sectional Results

Sectionals are NRA matches that are shoot at clubs across the country. The scores are then sent to the NRA and compiled into national rankings. These results are published to produce national championships. The results this month are from the Open Sectionals where anyone is eligible to shoot, both adults and juniors. Our matches draw participants from the local area and sometimes Grand Junction or Wyoming.

4-position smallbore

This consists of 20 shots in each of prone, standing, kneeling and sitting.

At our local match, Taylor Beard was the winner, Aaron Routh was match 2nd Scott Franz was 2nd Marksman and Samantha Trisdale was 3rd Marksman. There was no team match.

We only have 2 matches a year where we shoot 4-position. Because of this, most of our kids only practice it a couple of times a year. Even with that, we had 3 kids shoot in the top 100 shooters in the country. They were Taylor Beard, Aaron Routh and Scott Franz.

NRA 3-position smallbore

This match consists of 20 shots in each of prone, standing and kneeling. NRA 3-position allows straps on jackets and any sights – either iron or scopes.

At our local match, Scott Franz was match 2nd, Aaron Routh was 1st Master, and Samantha Trisdale was 2nd Marksman. Cherry Creek won the team event.

Nationally, Scott Franz was 3rd Sharpshooter and Taylor Beard was 17th Expert. Three of our juniors finished in the top 100. They were Scott Franz, Aaron Routh and Taylor Beard. Cherry Creek had the 1st Expert team.

International 3-position smallbore

This match consists of 20 shots in each of prone, standing and kneeling. The International 3-position smallbore differs from the NRA smallbore because does not allow scopes on rifles or straps on jackets.

Locally, Taylor Beard was match 2nd, Aaron Routh was 1st Master, Scott Franz was 2nd Marksman and Samantha Trisdale was 3rd Marksman. Cherry Creek won the team event.

Nationally, Scott Franz was 2nd Marksman, Taylor Beard was 14th Expert, Aaron Routh was 23rd Expert, Samantha Trisdale was 14th Marksman and Megan English was 19th Marksman. We had Taylor Beard, Aaron Routh and Scott Franz finish in the top 100 shooters. Cherry Creek had the 1st Sharpshooter team.

Air Rifle

This event consists of 60 shots shoot of standing. Locally, Scott Franz was Match winner, Taylor Beard was 1st Expert, Kayla Franz was 2nd Marksman and Megan English was 3rd Marksman. Cherry Creek was the team winner.

Nationally, this was our strongest event. Scott Franz was 3rd Marksman, Taylor Beard was 10th Expert, Kayla Franz was 10th Marksman, Samantha Trisdale was 18th Expert, Megan English was 22nd Marksman, Chiara Trisdale was 24th Marksman and Dustin English was 28th Marksman. Scott Franz, Taylor Beard and Samantha Trisdale finished in the top 100. Cherry Creek was the 1st Expert Team and the 2nd Marksman Team
