Many members may already know this but the Newsletter is now being distributed via email. We doing this to help reduce the amount of money it costs to produce and mail the newsletter. The more people we can get switched over to email only, the more we can save. This money can then, of course, be routed into other projects

Currently it costs .27 cents per newsletter to mail and about .70 cents each to print. This doesn't sound like a lot, but with our membership constantly growing, every little bit will help. In addition, this doesn't count the cost of the bulk mailing permit nor the cost of returned mail when an address is incorrect.

Now that we have the service for emailing the newsletters is set up and in place, we need our members to help make this a smooth process.

**Special Announcement from the Board**

**New Procedure for applying for membership**  
 For all members with prospective members and visitors wishing to apply to join. A new process started in November at the Board meeting. Be sure to read this all the way through as it is very different from what we have been doing in the past.

All new prospective members are now required to go through a background check. This is being done by a private investigative service and is a separate entity of the Club. Their main duty is to run a background check to verify that applicants are legally able to purchase, possess and use a firearm.

Applications will now be turned in at the Board meeting the month before the applicants joining month.

Applications will no longer be accepted and voted on at the general meeting, any applications turned in at the general meeting will not be considered until the next month.

This means that the applicant will bring in the application, their funds and a copy of their drivers license to the December Board meeting. The application will be accepted and processed and they will then join officially in December at the General Meeting if all is returned acceptable. If not their funds will be returned to them as quickly as possible.

See chart below with dates to help understand the process.

This schedule is for the remaining of this year and the 2006 year.

The fees for Juniors will stay consistent through the year and are not prorated down as the Regular and associate fees are. Regular members will pay a work bond, associate members and juniors do not.

Please be sure to read the chart and understand when things are to happen so that this transition can run as smooth as possible.

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by President Don Shearer.
2. The minutes from October's Meetings were approved as published in the newsletter.
3. Board Reports:
  - (a) Bill Bierbach reported that we had 22 Scouts shoot in November's Scout Night Program. The turn out has been overwhelming in the past few months.
  - (b) Don Eyser and Warren Johnston had a good turn out for the November Work Party. All the target carriers, that had problems, were fixed in November.
4. Old Business:
  - (a) George Wright gave the board an update on who is running for the Board of Directors.
  - (b) George Wright gave a report to the Board on the work that has been done on the new ventilation system. 10 new exhaust fans have been installed in the East and West Ranges. The club benefited by the free labor provided by a few members. George Wright donated about 10 hours a day for 6 weeks. George had a small group of members who volunteered their time to help with the work.
