First Match of the Season

On October 22nd, the juniors competed in their first match of the winter season. This was a Preliminary Tryout (PTO) held at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs. The match included 3 Olympians and current national team members. Men and women competed separately, except in the prone event.

We had 6 juniors (4 women and 2 men) compete in the air rifle event. In the women's events, Samantha Trisdale was 3rd overall with a 385 (out of a possible 400), Chiara Trisdale was 5th with a 374, Ryann McGough was 6th with a 372 and Megan English was 7th with a 370. At the end of the 10 shot final, Chiara and Ryann traded places. In the men's events, Tim Sherry was 6th with a 523 (out of 600) and Conlan McGough was 7th with a 515.

In smallbore prone, we had 3 juniors shooting, 1 man and 2 women. Megan was 7th with a 577 (out of a possible 600), Ryann was 9th with a 567 and Conlan was 10th with a 550.

In smallbore 3-position, we had 3 juniors shooting, all of them women. Megan was 4th with a 555 (out of 600), Samantha was 5th with a 552 and Chiara was 6th with a 500.

I want to give you and idea about how challenging the smallbore events are. The targets are set at a distance of 50 meters, the 10 ring is only .4 inches in diameter and rifle scopes are not allowed (only peep sights). With this challenge, we have juniors who are capable of consistently shooting strings of 90+ in standing.

I have a correction from the September newsletter. Under the heading 2005 Junior 3-P Junior Olympics, I should have pointed out that Scott Franz received the Silver medal in his age group and Kayla Franz tied with Samantha Trisdale for the Bronze Medal in their age

group. Kayla just missed the Bronze medal in the tie breaking procedure.

We shoot on Thursday evenings. As always, if you know of any young person (male or female) who would like to try competitive rifle shooting, have them contact Gary Trisdale at 303-367-8733 or at gtrisdale@earthlink.net. No experienced required and no equipment needed to start.
