1. The meeting was called to order at 7:24 PM by the President, George Wright.
2. Minutes of the last meeting were accepted as published in *The Firing Line*.
3. Old Business:
 - (a) Discussion of Tom Rodriguez's suggestion for reimbursement of mileage expenses to BOD members (refer to the prior BOD Meeting Minutes). Don Shearer presented the report by the committee previously convened to investigate it (Don Shearer, Chuck Towne, Gary Trisdale). The committee recommended not instituting a BOD mileage reimbursement for reasons including the potential expense and the difficulty in instituting a process equitable to BOD and volunteer members. A motion to accept the report was made and accepted by vote of the Board.
 - (b) Curt Lackey reported that the "turbulator pipe" at the end of the heat vent needs to be replaced to retain more of the heat at the far end of the pipes (too much heat is allowed to escape). He and George Wright will replace one and test it. (This is the same type of system used at Arvada Gun Club, where it is very effective with the correct turbulator in place.)
 - (c) George Wright reported that we have approximately 300 Corby Cards in reasonable condition, plus the hardware other than door magnets, available for sale. A motion was made and accepted to ask \$2000 for the cards and hardware.
 - (d) Chuck Towne found that the jumpers on the target turners are showing wear and will investigate replacement.
 - (e) A committee was appointed to develop a plan for liquidating the remaining donated equipment for the benefit of the Juniors. Clark Calve, Bill Bierbach, and Gary Trisdale will meet and report back to the BOD.
4. The meeting was adjourned at 8:02 PM.
