There's been quite a bit of activity on creating a new web site for CCGC over the past month. I'm writing this article on Friday, 1/27 but by the time you read it, some of the information could be obsolete. If so, I'll regard it as a good thing because it means we're moving faster than expected.

Our site is <http://www.cherrycreekgunclub.org> - NOT .com, it is .org. Yes, there are reasons for that and you can email me if you're curious.

What you'll see on the site today (1/27) is what Dave Epps put together. You'll know you're seeing the Epps Site if it says "Welcome to Cherry Creek Gun Club" at the very top. Lots of thanks to Dave for having created a site that we could get up and running quickly.

Over the past month, a committee of me (Bill Collins), Dave Pritchett, and Dave Goodlette have built a whole new site.

The new site, which might be up and running by the time this hits the presses, has the CCGC logo and "CCGC" at the top - that's how you'll know that you're seeing the new site. It has all the content from Dave's site (another reason that I'm thankful for Dave's effort - we didn't have to author all new text) plus links to various other sites and email form for contacting us. Plus we're gaining more web presence: the Encyclopedia of Bullseye Pistol is now carrying a link back to us.

What's coming in the future? How about a member login so you can see the calendar, contact information, and the Firing Line? ## Headed to Junior Olympics

One of the biggest matches of the year is the Colorado Junior Olympic Shooting Championship State Qualifier. Each state holds a separate qualifier. For men and women separately, the top 90 air rifle and 60 small-bore juniors are invited to the Olympic Training Center to shoot a head-to-head match. They sleep in the dorms and eat in the cafeteria. It is a great experience.

For the men, Scott Franz took the Gold Medal in both air rifle and small-bore, Aaron Routh was first J1 (18 - 20 years old) in air rifle and took the Bronze medal in small-bore, Dustin English was 2nd J1 in both air and small-bore, Tim Sherry was 2nd J3 (14 and younger) in air rifle, and Conlan McGough was 3rd J3 in air rifle and 1st J3 in small-bore. For the women, Ryann McGough took the Silver Medal in air rifle and small-bore, Taylor Beard took the Bronze in air and Gold in small-bore, Samantha Trisdale took the Gold in air rifle and the Bronze in small-bore, Megan English was the 2nd J2 (15 - 17 years old) in air, Kayla Franz was the 1st J3 in air, and Chiara Trisdale was the 2nd J3 in air.

All of the state qualifiers either shoot on our junior team or are members of Cherry Creek. Scott Franz is the men's state qualifier in both air rifle and small-bore. Ryann McGough is the women's state qualifier in air rifle and Taylor Beard is the women's state qualifier in small-bore. In addition to the above, invitations have been arriving at other home this past week. Conlan McGough, Tim Sherry, Chiara Trisdale, and Samantha Trisdale have notified me that they received invitations to attend. It is likely that there are others and I will list their names next month.

The other match in January was the NRA Indoor Conventional Small-bore Sectional. The scores shot at this match are forwarded to the NRA and combined to create a National Championship. This Sectional consists of a 3-position and 4-position match. We had some excellent scores in both of these matches. In the 3-position match, Scott Franz won with a score of 1149, Ryann McGough

was the 1st Master with a score of 1140 and Megan English was the 1st Marksman with a score of 1102. In the 4-position match, Scott Franz won with a score of 792 and Samantha Trisdale was the 1st Marksman with a score of 783. We may have had a new national record shot by one of the juniors and have submitted the paperwork to the NRA.

We shoot on Thursday evenings. As always, if you know of any young person (male or female) who would like to try competitive rifle shooting, have them contact Gary Trisdale at 303-367-8733 or at gtrisdale@earthlink.net. No experienced required and no equipment needed to start.

**Procedure for applying for membership**

All new prospective members are now required to go through a background check. This is being done by a private investigative service and is a separate entity of the Club. Their main duty is to run a background check to verify that applicants are legally able to purchase, possess and use a firearm.

Applications will now be turned in at the Board meeting the month before the applicants joining month.

The meeting was called to order at 7:40 PM by George Wright, President.

1. Minutes of the last meeting were accepted as published in the newsletter.
2. Correspondence: Notice from Arapahoe Library District to renew our listing in the *InfoArapahoe Community Guide*.

### 3. Board Reports

- a) Clark Calve is still holding one new member card and has one locker available.
- b) Bill Bierbach: good turnout for Boy Scouts last week. Had 2 complaints about janitor service and will call the janitor.
- c) Gary Trisdale: Juniors had a match 2 weeks ago with good results. Has submitted Samantha Trisdale's kneeling score as she may have set a national record. Five have been invited to the Junior Olympics Shooting Championships at the Olympic Training Center.
- d) Lee Ormiston: presented comparative financial statements for 2004 and 2005.
- e) Don Shearer: nothing to report.
- f) Dave Epps: holding one application that did not include proper fees and one check that came with no form.
- g) Bill Collins: turned in check for NRA membership renewal commissions.
- h) George Wright: Heating system complete pending increase of gas pressure from Xcel. These final adjustments are pending Curt Lackey's return from out of town; Xcel has had some trouble with their equipment causing the delay.
- i) George Wright/Lee Ormiston: CCGC now has a club credit card/bank check card to simplify payment of certain bills such as CMP renewal.
- j) George Wright: Dave Pritchett going in for back surgery.
- k) Lee Ormiston: discussed problem with a work bond refund that was cashed but recipient says it was not his. Bank shows it was deposited to his account.
- l) Bill Collins: Dave Pritchett has 5 people lined up for tube inspections; George will get their names from Dave and proceed with it.

### 4. Old Business:

- a) Don Shearer: Property next door to the east is owned by a developer planning to build townhomes who plans to let water drain to our property and has submitted such information to Arapahoe County Planning. Don took elevation readings with his GPS that indicate slope is to the east (Dayton St.) from that property. Don will take that information to the Planning Meeting (next Tuesday, 9:30 AM) and inform the committee that we do not want the drainage onto our property (i.e., we will not grant an easement).
- b) Don Shearer: Spoke to Bob Lees concerning the Attorney's fees outstanding. He spoke clearly to him concerning the Board's impressions of Attorney Sheffels' work. The Board has already voted to pay the negotiated amount and will do so. Don will continue to be the contact point for completion of revisions to the Club's Articles of Incorporation.

### 5. New Business:

- a) Dave Epps received thirteen new member applications for the February 10 General Meeting.
- b) Bill Collins made a motion to move the Board Meetings and General Meetings to 7:00 PM. The motion was approved.
- c) George Wright read a letter from member Lewis Funk requesting inactive status. The inactive status was voted on and accepted.
- d) Bill Collins presented the new CCGC web site. It will go live this weekend.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:30 PM
