Colorado 3-position Air Rifle State Championships

On May 6, we held the NRA state championship for 3-position air rifle. Megan English was 1st, with an excellent score of 588. Samantha Trisdale was 2nd, Ryann McGough was 4th, Tim Sherry was 5th Conlan McGough was 7th and Chiara Trisdale was 9th. A team of 4, plus 1 alternate is invited to the NRA National Air Gun Matches in Redmond, OR.

NRA Smallbore Postal National Results

The NRA postals are matches where teams from all over the country shoot at their local club and send the targets into the NRA for final scoring. The NRA compiles all of the scores and publishes national results. Our juniors did very well. We won 11 of the 13 available individual junior awards. In the team matches, we entered 4 teams and won 4 awards.

In individual events, the categories are Junior (JR), age 18-20; Intermediate Junior (IJ), age 15-17; and Sub-junior (SJ), age 14 and younger. Aaron Routh was 1st JR in 4-position, Ryann McGough was 1st IJ in both 3 and 4-position, Megan English was 2nd IJ in both 3 and 4-position, Samantha Trisdale was 1st SJ in both 3 and 4-position, Chiara Trisdale was 2nd SJ in 4-position and 3rd SJ in 4-position; Conlan McGough was 3rd SJ in 4-position and Tim Sherry was 4th SJ in 4-position.

In 3-position teams, Samantha, Ryann, Megan and Aaron won 1st place; Dustin, Chiara, Conlan and Tim won 3rd place. In 4-position teams, Dustin, Ryann, Megan and Aaron won 1st place; and Samantha, Chiara, Conlan and Tim won 2nd place.

NRA Open Sectional National Results

The NRA Sectionals are major matches that are shot at several locations throughout the country. The NRA takes the results of these local matches and produces a national result bulletin. In these matches the juniors compete against adults, including members of the Army Marksmanship Unit. Against hundreds of shooters, we won 16 individual awards and 3 team awards.

In standing air rifle, we had 5 individual awards and 2 team awards. Ryann McGough was 6th expert, Samantha Trisdale was 2nd Sharpshooter, Megan English was 4th sharpshooter, Tim Sherry was 11th marksman

and Chiara Trisdale was 14th marksman. The team of Ryann, Samantha and Megan took 2nd place overall, beating everyone but the Army Marksmanship Unit. The team of Tim, Chiara and Conlan won 1st marksman.

In International 3-position smallbore, we had 4 individual awards and 1 team award. Aaron Routh was 1st expert, Ryann McGough was 4th expert, Samantha Trisdale was 1st marksman and Megan English was 5th marksman. The team of Aaron, Ryann, Samantha and Megan won the sharpshooter class by 65 points.

In the NRA 3-position smallbore, we had 3 individual awards. Ryann McGough was 10th expert, Megan English was 9th marksman and Chiara Trisdale was 16th marksman.

In the Conventional 4-position smallbore, we had 4 individual awards. Ryann McGough was 6th expert, Samantha Trisdale was 2nd

marksman, Megan English was 3rd marksman and Chiara Trisdale was 5th marksman.

Based on the above performances, several of the juniors will be moving up in classification.
