Juniors Sectionals

The kids did very well at the NRA Junior Sectionals.

Megan English was 2nd in her age group in air rifle, won the gold in 3-position air rifle, was first in her age group in 3-position smallbore, and 1st in her age group in 4-position smallbore. Scott Franz won the gold in air rifle and the silver in 3-position smallbore. Sarah Havens was first in her age group in air rifle. Ryann McGough was 2nd in air rifle, 3-position air rifle, and 4-position smallbore; and won the gold in 3-position smallbore.

Bobby Oberle shot in his first Junior Sectional and did well in both the 3-position and 4-position smallbore. Aaron Routh, in his last Junior Sectional, won the silver in 3-position air rifle, was 1st in his age group in 3-position smallbore and won gold in 4-position smallbore. Tim Sherry was 2nd in his age group in air rifle and 4-position smallbore; and 3rd in his age group in 3-position air rifle. Chiara Trisdale was 3rd in her age group in air rifle; and was 2nd in her age group in 3-position air rifle, 3-position smallbore, and 4-position smallbore. Samantha Trisdale was 1st in her age group in air rifle, 3-position air rifle and 3-position smallbore; and won the silver in 4-position smallbore. She tied the nation record in her age group in 4-position smallbore.

The team did very well in the team matches. The team of Ryann, Megan and Samantha won the air rifle and the team of Tim, Chiara and Conlan were 1st in their age group in air rifle. The team of Aaron, Megan, Ryann and Samantha won the 3-position air, 3-position smallbore and the 4-position smallbore. In 4-

position smallbore, they were 1 point short of tying the national record for a junior team. The team of Sarah, Chiara, Tim and Conlan were first in their age group in 3-position air rifle and 4-position smallbore.
