  - (c) Lee Ormiston paid the Liability Insurance this month.
  - (d) Gary Trisdale needs wall space for the plaques that the Junior Team has won (6).
  - (e) Bill Collins reported that people have joined the NRA through the web site and we received the commission.
  - (f) Don Shearer received a cross-section of the soil as related to water table and basements. The building project is still on.
5. New Business:
  - (a) Four new members were introduced: Jeremy Wedderburn, Steven Davison, Steven Bell, and James Vanar. The applicants spoke of their experience and interest in the club. George Wright reported that the applicants had all pass the background check. The members were voted into the club.
  - (b) George Wright noted that the Board has a party interested in purchasing the old Corby system and we need to price it.
  - (c) Bill Bierbach and Clark Calve will be at the Tanner Gun Show this weekend to sell various donated items to benefit the Juniors Team.

September 8, 2006, 7:00 PM at the Club House

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:03 PM by the President and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
2. Minutes published in the previous newsletter were accepted as published
3. There was no correspondence other than a coupon booklet for local retailers.
4. Board Reports:
  - (a) Clark Calve is holding 6 card keys for new members needing to complete the safety course.
  - (b) Lee Ormiston provided a report on the financial status of the club.
  - (c) Gary Trisdale reported that the Juniors second match of the season will be next weekend at the Olympic Training Center.
  - (d) Bill Collins reported on the loss of our printer that prints the newsletter. He is moving out of town.
  - (e) Curt Lackey is continuing to adjust the mixture for the heat.
  - (f) Don Eyser reported a good turnout for the last work party that was able to move out a good deal of the waste lead.
  - (g) Lee Ormiston reported a turnout of 15 Boy Scouts last Friday.
5. Old Business:
  - (a) Bill Collins read the names of the current nominees for next year – there are 13 nominees for 13 positions.
  - (b) Curt Lackey continues to tune the gas mixture for the heating on the pistol ranges.
  - (c) Bill Collins reported that Art Thayer will take over administration of the web site next year.
  - (d) Bill Collins reported on the candidates list for next year's Board.
  - (e) Don Shearer reported on the development to our east; they currently plan to run storm drainage north to Mississippi rather than over our property. Don, Lee Ormiston, and George Wright met last week to discuss options if the developer approaches us again for an easement (the Club remains uninterested in granting an easement). There may be a meeting the week of November 6 with neighborhood representatives, and another on November 21 with Arapahoe County Planning Commission.
6. New Business:
  - (a) The stock of sew member application forms are missing; George will contact Bill Bierbach to locate them.
  - (b) Gary Trisdale requested the use of both pistol ranges for the Juniors (matches) on January 6 & 7 from 8AM to 5PM, February 3 & 4 from 8AM to 5PM, and March 3 & 4 from 7AM to 6PM. A motion to accept the dates was made and passed.
  - (c) George Wright reported that the ventilation system for west range is now adjusted properly and the east range will be finalized shortly. Two carriers on the west range are

not functioning properly; the junction box at 50' on position 19 was struck by a bullet and damaged.

- (d) Tom Rodriguez (the club's accountant) presented a recommendation that the Board appoint a committee to evaluate mileage reimbursement for Board members consistent with practices at other not-for-profit organizations. A committee to study the question was formed, consisting of Gary Trisdale, Don Shearer (Chair), and Chuck Towne.
- (e) For the old Corby system, another club is interested but has not made a specific offer and a valuation has not been completed by CCGC. The valuation will be completed by the next Board meeting by Lee Ormiston and Tom Rodriguez.
- (f) George Wright reported that there are four new member applications that are being processed.

7. The meeting was adjourned at 7:48 PM.
