In order to honor his request that the donation directly benefit the Junior Program, the Board of Directors (BOD) has arranged to man a table at the Tanner Gun Show (Merchandise Mart/58th & I-25) on October 14th/15th for the purpose of converting the items to cash. Appraised values have already been obtained for pieces requiring them and approximate market value is being ascertained for the other articles.

She finished 5th in her age group for 3-position smallbore and 4th for standing air rifle. In both events, she shot personal records.

September 8, 2006, 7:00 PM at the Club House

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:03 PM by the President and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
2. Board Reports:
 - (a) Don Eyser reported that the next Work Party will be October 21st.
 - (b) Lee Ormiston provided a financial report.
 - (c) George Wright has recycled pop cans for the Juniors.
 - (d) Bill Bierbach reported that there were no Boy Scouts for the last practice. This was the same last September yet the remainder of the year had good turnouts.
 - (e) Bill Bierbach has janitors booked through the end of the year.
3. Old Business:
 - (a) Bill Collins reported on statistics for web site logins and recommended that the next newsletter publisher take on a project to produce an email newsletter in HTML format.

- (b) Bill Collins reported on the current list of candidates for the 2007 Board of Directors. The Board discussed the desire to have Board Members who will be **active** Board Members.
- (c) Don Shearer reported on the status of the building project to our east. Though the Arapahoe County Planning Commission turned down his request, the developer is still pursuing the project. (The concern is the developer's desire to run a storm sewer across our property.)

4. New Business:

- (a) Brad Lightner requested permission to keep an air cylinder on site; he would secure it in the vault. A motion was made and permission was granted by vote of the Board.
- (b) George reported that four new membership applications were accepted at the meeting.
- (c) George and Lee Eihausen tested the ventilation system without the old (original) exhaust fan. The West Range is balanced at 28%. The East Range will be rebalanced next.
- (d) Curt Lackey is working on a problem with the heating system and hopes to have it resolved within a month.
- (e) Dave Pritchett will not be able to function as Secretary for the next two months because of work commitments.
- (f) George recommended that the 2007 Membership Renewals be done by mailing an invoice to the membership; he provided a prototype invoice/renewal form. This should be more convenient for the membership and efficient for the Club. A motion was passed to perform the renewals in the manner described.
- (g) Don Eyser is working to repair the water fountain (the drain seal leaks; the water is currently turned off).
- (h) Bill Bierbach reported that the Club will be selling a variety of donated items at the next Tanner Gun Show. Don Eyser will assist Bill at the show. Proceeds will benefit the Juniors.
- (i) Curt Lackey reported on a clinic for Advanced Bullseye Pistol Shooters and inquired about the cost to rent the range.

5. The meeting was adjourned at 8:20 PM.
