CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB GENERAL MEMBERS MEETING

March 9, 2007, 7:00 PM at the Club House.

1. Meeting called to order at 7:03 PM by George Wright.
2. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by George Wright.
3. Minutes were accepted as published in the newsletter.
4. There was no correspondence to report.
5. Board Reports
 - a. Lee Ormiston –Scout Marksmanship next Friday.
 - b. Lee Ormiston Legislation ; (Lee will provide it on paper)
 - i. HB 1011 – postponed
 - ii. HB 07-1278 – Laid over until May 28 (firearms in vehicles not allowed without CCW)
 - iii. SB 07-034 – Reciprocity – passed,
 - iv. HB 07-069 Similar to 07-1278 and postponed indefinitely
 - v. Background check fee increase referred to the next committee
 - vi. Federal - Court decision allowing possession of firearms is allowed in DC and 2nd Amendment **does** apply to individuals!
 - vii. Federal – HB 1022 (Clinton gun ban) is in committee
 - viii. Federal – HB 1096 – in committee, affirms that 2nd Amendment is for individuals.
 - c. Denise Henry – newsletter production is going well, with thanks to Steve Wilson, Art Thayer, and George Wright.
 - d. Warren Johnston – next work party is March 17, 8AM to noon. Also looking for someone to help transport 2 pieces of 25’ angle iron to bring to the club.
 - e. Gary Trisdale – match last weekend, 40 Juniors participated, and many produced excellent scores. Five Juniors will be competing at the Junior Olympics next week.
 - f. Clark Calve has 1 card pending a new member safety orientation.
 - g. Lee Eihausen – bank accounts are in good shape.
6. Old Business
 - a. East pistol range painting is nearly done. There is a significant difference in brightness. East Range is closed until 3PM Monday for the floor paint to dry.
 - b. NRA membership is required for all members and a letter will be going out to all members notifying them that membership (and expiration date) are required. It is needed for our insurance. “Pending” will no longer be accepted.
7. New Business
 - a. There will be a Senior Citizens Shoot held here. There are 6 couples that are members of an adventure group. It will be held April 7, 9AM to noon on the East Range.
 - b. George Wright read the new member applications from 11 applicants: Matthew Baldwin, Jim McGee, Clegg Williams, Robert Maple, Peter Lemire, Mike Pease, Peter TenEyck, David Pearson, Patrick Crotty, Dennis Osterman, and Jim Hindmarch. The members spoke of their experience as shooters and their interest in the Club; the sponsors spoke of their knowledge of the applicants and their safety. All were accepted by vote of the membership and will become full members upon completion of the Safety Orientation.

- c. Clark Calve reported on the Jefferson County SWAT Member whose car was broken into and firearm, etc., stolen. The Jefferson County Sheriff's Department was quoted in the Denver Post as saying, "We are concerned about weapons of any kind in the hands of someone other than law enforcement."

CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

March 30, 2007

Attendees: Wright, Eihausen, Thayer, Towne, Harrell, Ormiston, Shearer, Henry, Thrush, Johnston, and Lackey.

1. The meeting was called to order by George Wright at 7:02 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the U. S. of A.
2. The minutes to the last board meeting were approved as published.
3. George Wright reviewed the correspondence received.
4. Don Shearer reported receiving one call on the answering machine about the status of a new member. Also received was a call from the Denver VA Medical Center requesting the use of the range for a group for air rifle practice. Mike Hopkins and Tom Rodriguez will contact the organization.
5. Lee Ormiston reported that a scout representative has received information about the range and will see if the range usage will fit into their program.
6. Tom Thrush has received no response on the selling of the Corby system. He will keep trying with some modifications to the packaging and price.

7. Lee Ormiston reported on HB 1174, SB 034, and SB 109. HB 1174 concerns the repeal of the prohibition against a database for persons holding concealed carry permits for handguns. SB 034 concerns clarification of residency status for granting reciprocity of concealed carry permits issued by other states. SB 109 concerns the authority of the CBI to impose a fee for performing background checks prior to the transfer of a firearm. The federal assault ban bill is in committee.
 8. Lee Eihausen reported that the guest fees of \$1,500 should pay for the range paint work. The guest fee income has been much greater this year than in previous years.
 9. Warren Johnston said that the next work party will be on April 21st. He will try to work on the gutters on the east side of the roof.
 10. Curt Lackey reported receiving only two calls about the heat in the range.
 11. Darvin Harrell reported that the cost of new chairs and tables are expensive. Darvin was asked to provide pictures of the chairs and tables to aid in a discussion next meeting.
 12. George Wright said that the Senior Citizens Shoot will be next Sunday at 9 AM. The shoot will be with rifles and pistols by 60 to 66 year old citizens.
 13. The west range will be painted on April 21 and 22 and will be closed to usage until April 26.
 14. The Civic League will be discussed by the board after tax season.
 15. The committee on the club's checking accounts will head a discussion at the next board meeting.
 16. There are four new member applications pending.
 17. The Juniors have asked for range usage on Wednesday's from 5 until 8 PM for practice until next season starts. They will use only one side of the range.
 18. A letter from Lee Eihausen about a group of six shooters using the range for instruction from a member. The board discussed the policy and will review same next board meeting.

19. George Wright said that the painting of the east range was about \$400. The sound insulation panels close to the backstop in the west range have been damaged. George has hung a rubber sheet on the west wall at the backstop which appears to minimize damage to the paneling. The rubber sheeting costs about \$400 for an 8 x 20 foot sheet. Only the west range appears to need the sheeting.

20. The meeting was adjourned at 8:13 PM.
