CREEK GUN CLUB GENERAL MEMBERS MEETING

- January 12,2007 at the club house

1. The meeting was called to order by George Wright at 7:01 pm.
2. the membership pledged to allegiance to the flag of the USA.
3. The minutes to the last general meeting were approved with one change; Art Thayer will head the tube qualification, not George Wright.
4. Don Shearer reported checking the answering machine and that a lady requested meeting room usage for a home safety course. Don will contact her about the details.
Clark Calve is holding seven entry cards pending these new members taking the safety course.
5. Art Thayer reported that he needs to get with Bill Collins about the web site.

6. Warren Johnston said that the work party dates are posted, that a new large calendar is needed, and that the work party dates will be posted on the web site.
 7. The newsletter editors need to get with Bill Collins for the format of the newsletter.
 8. Lee Ormiston reported on the Boy Scout's marksmanship program. More instructors are needed. Lee said that HB7-1011 allows physical force to be used against intruders as a break-in implies potential bodily harm. Lee said that he has a list of six scout instructors.
 9. The new membership and janitorial chairman asked that workers contact him to volunteer to work as janitors.
 10. Curt Lackey said that the last Arvada meeting was cancelled due to weather and that there is, therefore , no new news on the Corby system sell to Arvada
 11. 12. George Wright has feelers out on the material to protect the wall behind the backstop. Various plans, intentions, and material were discussed.
 12. George Wright introduced six applicants for membership. Each applicant talked of their interest in the club, their sponsors talked of their safety habits, and all were accepted into the club by unanimous vote. The new members are: Patrick Barnett, Jerry Netolicky, Rodney Erkson, Leslie Kazmeroff, Gerrett Oberholman and Dennis Young. Erkson and Oberlolman were not sponsored and will have to take the safety course with Clark Calve. The next tube qualification session will be Friday at 6:30 pm.

George Wright proposed painting the pistol range backstop, walls and floor a light color to improve lighting in the range for those who shoot at distances different from where the range lights are situated. George estimates the cost will be about \$2,100 for the primer, paint , and overcoat. The proposal was discussed and tabled for the board of directors.
 14. A question on whether the ventilation fans could be disconnected from the light switch to improve heating on very cold days , was discussed. The ventilation is required to keep the air clean for the health of shooter.
 15. The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 pm.

1. The meeting was called to order by George Wright at 7:01 PM.
 2. The members present pledged allegiance to the flag of the U. S. of A.
 3. The minutes to the last board meeting were approved as published.
 4. Don Shearer reported receiving one call on the answering machine about a members work bond.
 5. Clark Calve reported that he is sitting on six access cards pending those members taking the safety course.
 6. Lee Ormiston reported on bill C0507034 which requires those with concealed carry permits from other states must have a picture ID from the out-of-state state. HB 07011 will add that one must have a reasonable fear of bodily harm to defend himself.
 7. George Henry still needs to get with Bill Collins concerning the newsletter.
 8. Gary Trisdale reports that the Juniors have had two matches so far and will submit an article about them. An open match will be held February 3 and 4.
 9. Warren Johnston said that the next work party will be on February 17 from 8 until 12 AM.
 10. Art Thayer was asked to prepare a work party schedule for the newsletter.
 11. Lee Eihausen reported receiving enough membership fees to pay the property taxes on both properties.
 12. Darvin Harrell reported that the janitorial schedule is going good and that he is keeping up with the membership entries.
 13. Chuck Towne reported that materials for the loose receptacles

have been obtained and that work to replace the loose ones will be ongoing.

14. George Wright has written a letter to a member who did not pass his back ground check denying him membership. The issue was discussed. A motion was made and passed to delete him from the club.
15. George Wright said that a prospective new member refused to give his social security number which enables a back ground check. His money has been returned and he was given an opportunity to address the board.
16. George Wright reported that the Arvada Gun Club will not purchase the Corby system. The system will be put on E-bay to sell by Tom Thrush and George Wright will box the system up.
17. George Wright said that a church youth group of girls 12 to 18 years old will be using the east range on February 27 from 5 to 8 PM for an introduction to 22 rifle shooting. Volunteers are needed to help out.
18. George Wright said that new member applications have been received.
19. George Wright reported that property tax statements have been received. The developed property tax is \$14,400 and the undeveloped property tax is \$7,400.
20. George Wright proposed the painting of the walls and floors of the pistol ranges. The estimated cost will be \$560 per range and will require that the range be closed for 24 hours for the paint to dry. The proposal was discussed and a motion to authorize \$800 to paint the floors and walls passed. The board discussed the color.
21. Lee Ormiston asked about the status of the work to protect the back wall from damage. A suggestion was made to hang steel plates at an angle to deflect bullets. Curt Lackey said that Arvada Gun Club has some steel which may work.
22. The meeting was adjourned at 8:11 PM.
