The juniors shot 2 major matches in December. The first was the 3 Times Air Match in Colorado Springs. This match consists of 3 standing air rifle matches over 3 days. At this match, Tim Sherry set a national record for his age group on Friday and then turned around and broke his own record on Saturday. The USA Shooting web site with the results of the match is down as I write this. The results of this match will be included next month.

The Colorado Junior Olympic Shooting Championships, held at the OTC in Colorado Springs, determines who is invited to the National Junior Olympic Shooting Championships in the spring. This match consists of standing air rifle (40 shot women, 60

shot men) and 3-position smallbore. We had 7 of our regular shooters participate in this match: Megan English, Conlan McGough, Ryann McGough, Bobby Oberle, Tim Sherry, Chiara Trisdale, and Samantha Trisdale. Ryann McGough, Tim Sherry and Chiara Trisdale are guaranteed an automatic invitation in air rifle based on their scores at the match. Others were very close and will have to wait to see if they also receive invitations. The final list of attendees will be included in a future newsletter.

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by the President, George Wright.

4. Correspondence:
 - (a) Wyoming State Pistol Championship in Rawlins, WY.
 - (b) Whittington Center donation request. Lee Ormiston pointed out that we do maintain a club membership there.
 - (c) Shooting Sports magazine.
5. Board Reports:
 - (a) Clark Calve has 9 cards for new members needing to complete the Safety Course.
 - (b) Don Eyser thanked the work parties that worked so hard to remove the lead. The revenue from the sale (30,000 pounds of lead) and has been turned over to the Juniors Program.
 - (c) Bill Bierbach has found a volunteer to take over Janitor coordination duties.
 - (d) Gary Trisdale – the Juniors have a match all day Saturday (tomorrow) and half-day on Sunday. (Both Ranges).
 - (e) Lee Ormiston reported that we have received the CMP renewal forms which he turned over to George Wright to give to the (to be determined) 2007 Treasurer.
 - (f) Lee Ormiston reported on the financial status of the Club.
