- 4. Lee Ormiston reported on the many state and federal bills with the word "firearms" in them. State Senate Bill 07-034 concerning the clarification of reciprocity of concealed carry permits by other states was discussed. This bill went to the governor on April 7. HB 07-1174 concerning a repeal of the prohibition against databases for persons holding concealed carry permits was discussed. This bill went to the governor on May 8. Several federal bills were discussed.
- 5. Clark Calve said that he was holding no membership cards.
- 6. Warren Johnston reported that the next work party would be tomorrow. The number of 1 x 1 angle pieces needed was discussed.
- 7. Gary Trisdale said that the Juniors were ready for the summer season.
- 8. Lee Eihouser said that the bank accounts were OK.
- 9. Art Thayer reported that he will put up a sign up sheet for the tube certification classes.
- 10. George Wright said that he is mailing out requests for NRA membership numbers for those members who have not given that information to the club. The goal is for 100 percent NRA membership which will reduce the club's insurance premiums.
- 11. George said that action will be taken for those members who are using the range but have not paid their dues for 2007.
- 12. George Wright introduced three applicants for membership. Each applicant talked of their interest in the club and all were accepted into the club by unanimous vote. The new members are: Jody Ginger, Arthur Martinez, and Michael Eide. All of the new members will take the safety course.
- 13. The meeting was adjourned at 7:20 PM.

CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

May 25, 2007

Attendees: Wright, Eihausen, Johnston, Calve, Towne, Shearer, Henry, Thrush, Ormiston, and guest Bierbach.

- 1. The meeting was called to order by George Wright at $7:01\ PM$ followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the U. S. of A.
- 3. The minutes to the last board meeting were approved as published.
- 4. A letter from the Denver Council of the Boy Scouts concerning the termination of CCGC's involvement in scout shooting for merit badges was read by George Wright.
- 5. Warren Johnston said that the next work party would be on June 16.
- 6. Tom Thrush reported that the sell of the Corby system via the internet is still in work.
- 7. Clark Calve is holding four entry cards of new members pending their taking the safety course.
- 8. George Wright asked member Robert Ringler is explain why he loaned his access key to a member who said that he had lost his key. Mr. Ringler knew that the man he loaned the key to was a member and a friend. The board gave Mr. Ringler a verbal reprimand. Mr. Ringler apologized to the board for his violation of the club rules.
- 9. A request by Les Hayes to use the range to conduct NRA classes was discussed. Mr. Hayes will conform to all rules and will return 10 % of the class income to the club. A motion to allow the classes was passed unanimously.
- 10. Don Shearer reported that all club activity leaders will be reporting their activity income and expenses for tax purposes. A policy motion requiring all CCGC activity leaders to provide itemized income and expense reports for the calendar year or season to the treasurer. The motion passed unanimously. One

comment from an activity leader was that the board has not shown proper appreciation for their efforts in conducting the activity in the past.

- 11. Lee Ormiston reported that the Castle Rock chapter of the Boy Scouts had 9 scouts plus instructors at the last session. A lady with three scouts from the Denver Chapter arrived and, due to the termination of CCGC's involvement with this chapter, were turned away. After a discussion, a motion to leave the BSA equipment and money in place for up to three years at which time it will revert to the club. The motion passed unanimously.
- 12. Don Shearer reported on a request by Veterans who wish to shoot to use the range. As soon as the Veterans accumulate funds, they will contact the club for further consideration.
- 13. George Wright discussed the misplaced shots found recently in the pistol range. There are bullet marks on the newly painted floor and on the range light protective plates which are believed to be hits made on purpose. The camera tapes will be reviewed to find the perpetrator(s).
- 14. There are two new member applications pending.
- 15. The property grass has been cut. A suggestion to drag the parking lot to redistribute the gravel was discussed.
- 16. The meeting was adjourned at 7:59 PM.
