CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

April 13, 2007

1. The meeting was called to order by George Wright at 7:00 PM.
2. The membership pledged allegiance to the flag of the USA
3. The minutes to the last general meeting were approved as published.
4. The correspondence received was reviewed with no action necessary.
5. Gary Trisdale reported that the Central Division Winter League is over and that Samantha Trisdale won the competition.
6. Art Thayer asked whether everyone received the newsletter via his e-mail attachment. The consensus seems to be that this is an easy way to distribute the newsletter.
7. Lee Eihausen said that the guest fee income is doing well. It was noted that the guest fee income has steadily increased over the last few years.
8. Lee Ormiston reported on the state and federal legislation pending. Lee reported on HB07-1174 which is being considered by the House, SB07-034 which has gone to the governor, and SB07-109 which has been postponed indefinitely. 9. Warren Johnston said that the next work party will be April 21 from 8 until noon.
10. Painting of the west range will be April 20 from 5 PM through Sunday. The west range will be closed through April 24. Volunteers are needed to help paint. The wall protective rubber sheeting will be hung next week.
11. A Senior Citizens Shoot consisted of six couples who knew nothing of what to expect. They shot everything from 22 rifles, pistols and high power rifles and had a blast doing it. Several members helped officiate.
12. The pen shooters are making hits into the side walls in front of the backstop. Some protective rubber sheeting will be hung on the walls some twenty feet out from the back stop.
13. George Wright introduced four applicants for membership. Each applicant talked of their interest in the club, their sponsors talked of their safety habits, and all were accepted into the club by unanimous vote. The new members are: Camden Mollohan, Steven Isaak, Matthew Veatch, and Joseph McCaffrey. All of the new members will take the safety course.
14. Since the east range was painted, multiply hits are evident on the t-bar ceiling and on the floor. A diagram has been posted showing where to place a target to prevent hits other than in the back stop. Violators will be asked to explain their carelessness to the board.
15. A member reported that Winchester Wildcat 22 long rifle ammunition of certain lot numbers have been recalled due to the possibility of having a double charge. Visit the Winchester web site for details.
16. Volunteers are needed for painting the west range and to help repair the gutters during the Saturday work party.

CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

May 25, 2007

Attendees: Wright, Eihausen, Harrell, Towne, Calve, Thayer, Ormiston, Shearer, Henry, Trisdale, and Johnston.

1. The meeting was called to order by George Wright at 7:02 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the U. S. of A.
3. The minutes to the last board meeting were approved as published.
4. Denise Henry had issue with the U. S. Postal Service for damaged newsletters. One damaged newsletter had an anti-club comment written on it.
5. Warren Johnston said that the next work party would be on May 12.
6. Gary Trisdale said that five kids would be going to an USA shooting match in Georgia.
7. Lee Ormiston commented on the following legislative bills;
 - SB 07-034 – Clarification of reciprocity on concealed carry permits
 - HB 07-1174 – Repeal of ban against a database for concealed carry permit holders
 - HR 1874 – Ban firearms which do not micro-print on a cartridge
 - HR 1022 – Assault weapons ban
 - HR 226 – Provides a national standard for nonresidents to carry in that state
 - HR 96 – Closes a gun show loop hole
 - HR 73 – Citizens’ Self-Defense Act (OK to gun owners)
 - HR 1784 – PLEA Act, bans certain ammunition
 - HR 1897 – National Park Second Amendment Restoration and Personal Protection Act of 2007 (OK to gun Owners)
8. Lee Eihausen reported over a quarter million in three accounts.
9. George Wright introduced a member who had brought a quest to the Club. The guest was shooting at a moving target and his shots were striking the floor instead of the backstop. The Member apologized to the board for his infraction of the rules.
10. George Wright reported that the range painting is complete and that the rubber sheeting has been hung next to the backstop in the West range. George acknowledged the members who helped with the work.
11. George Wright reported that the new used chairs were obtained by Tom Thrush and that Dave Epps is trying to obtain tables.
12. George Wright said that work is in process of getting the Civic League going.
13. Don Shearer reported that there are five checking accounts each of which is used for a specific club activity. Efforts are required to provide accountability of these accounts to the club.

14. A discussion concerning the Boy Scouts lack of attendance which wastes the time of the club members who help with the program. A motion to terminate relations with the Denver BSA Council, maintain the program dependent on calls, to hold the May 18 class for the Castle Rock BSA Council and reevaluate the program after May 18. The motion passed unanimously.
 15. Six new member applications will be considered next general meeting.
 16. The board discussed the policy of limiting NRA classes to one per quarter. A motion passed unanimously to allow instructors to hold classes as required and that participants must sign the “no blame” form. Denise Henry and Art Thayer will control the scheduling of these classes.
 17. Don Shearer said that the Veterans Medical Center wants to use the range on an irregular basis for air gun practice. A motion passed to pursue the program.
 18. George Wright read a letter requesting allowance to practice holster work (quick drawing). A motion to not change the policy which does not allow holster work passed.
 19. The board discussed the practice by some members who do not pay their membership fees by March 1. The board agreed that those who do not pay by March 1 will have their access cards turned off and that they will then have to come to a general or board meeting to obtain a renewal form.
 20.
