BULLSEYE PISTOL LEAGUE

Winter 2007-2008

Sponsored by the Cherry Creek Gun Club (pending NRA approval)

DATES & TIMES: This is a Monday evening league, beginning on Monday, October 22nd with an orientation, sign-up and opportunity for practice. It continues on Mondays for the next 20 weeks except for December 24th and December 31st. The last shooting night will be March 23rd and the awards night will be March 30th. Shooting begins at 4:30 PM and continues until 8:00 PM. You may shoot whenever is convenient for you, on a first come first serve basis.

LOCATION: Cherry Creek Gun Club indoor range, 1310 South Clinton Street in Aurora, 2 blocks south of Mississippi and 0.7 miles west of Havana.

COURSE OF FIRE: Each relay will be a National Match Course including 10 shots of slow fire, 10 shots of timed fire and 10 shots of rapid fire, all at 25 yards. To complete league requirements you will need to shoot a minimum of 15 scored relays per gun, and a maximum of 20 scored relays per gun. You may decide which relays will be practice and which will be scored at your own discretion, but once you have begun scoring on a score card you must complete scoring of that relay. You may shoot multiple relays per night, space allowing. When the line is full shooters may shoot two relays before they must allow a waiting shooter to take their point on the line.

ENTRY FEES: The league allows shooting either a .22 pistol or a center fire caliber pistol or both. Entry fee for one pistol is \$50 and for both is \$65. Checks for the entry fee should be made payable to Marita Keeling - Cherry Creek Gun Club. There is an additional \$7 fee if you wish your scores to be sent in to the NRA to obtain or change national classification as part of an NRA sanctioned league. (We need a minimum of 10 shooters for the league to be sanctioned.)

SIGN-UP: Sign up at Cherry Creek Gun Club on the first night or later. You may sign up through the end of January which will still allow for completion of the minimum 15 scored relays.

RULES: NRA rules will be used. If you have an NRA classification, you will compete in your assigned class. If you do not have an NRA pistol classification you will be assigned a class based on your league average last year, or if you are a new shooter, the average scores of your first five weeks' shooting this year. This league is NRA sanctioned and shooters can choose to obtain NRA bullseye pistol classifications.

SAFETY: Range safety is paramount and the Range Officer will direct firearm handling by competitors and direct safe operation of the range. However, it is the responsibility of all competitors to ensure that safety is maintained and any shooter may call a CEASE FIRE immediately if they observe a safety problem.

EQUIPMENT: Shooters will provide their own pistols, ammunition, hearing protection and shooting glasses. Ear and eye protection are required. The league will furnish targets. Please bring a stapler for mounting targets, as well as tape for repairs. The league can provide a few staplers, tape and spotting scopes. Sometimes .22 ammunition and ear plugs are available for sale.

FUN MATCHES: There will be one or two fun matches during the usual course of league. For example, there may be a "Saturday night special" competition and/or a revolver competition. Ideas for other fun matches are welcomed.

AWARDS: On March 30th the Awards presentations will take place at Cherry Creek Gun Club. There will be awards for the Overall League Winner, and winners in the Master, Expert, Sharpshooter and Marksman Classes. There will also be High Woman and Most Improved shooter awards. There are generally prizes worth about \$1000 and everyone attending the award presentation will have a trip to the prize table. Beverages and food will be provided as well.

WORK BOND: Cherry Creek Gun Club requires members to meet a work bond requirement. Assisting at league by setting up, tidying up, or calling courses of fire will meet this requirement. Members are also encouraged to call courses of fire or learn to do this. Please keep track of your time so that you can be credited for this.

 8. Denise Henry reported that the newsletter is doing well and that the minimum number of nominees for the 2008 board is almost there.
 9. Lee Eihausen reported that the treasury is OK.
 10. Art Thayer reported that he spent three hours working on the club's web site.
 11. George Wright said that the club's liability and casualty insurance are being updated. The liability insurance with the NRA has been renewed.
 12. George Wright introduced five applicants for membership. Each applicant talked of their interest in the club and all were accepted into the club by unanimous vote. The new members are: Mike Ross, Joseph Witt, Jr, Eric Deutcher, Casandra Medrano, and Erdenetuya Baasandambe. All will be taking the safety course with Clark Calve.
 13. A question was asked about when the Winter Pistol League starts.
 14. The meeting was adjourned at 7:28 PM.

October 26, 2007

1. The meeting was called to order by George Wright at 7:01 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the U. S. of A.
3. The minutes to the last board meeting were approved as published.
4. Clark Calve is still holding one new member's entry card pending the new member taking the safety course.

5. Gary Trisdale reported that the Juniors had their first match of the season at the OTC and that they did very well.
 6. George Henry reported that the department of the newsletter is under control and that member Reilley Smith has passed away.
 7. Warren Johnston announced that the next work party would be on November 17.
 8. Art Thayer said that he is still working on the web site and that he has received \$20 from the NRA for NRA membership fees.
 9. Lee Eihausen reported that the treasury is secure. He was asked for a comprehensive treasurer's report for the December General meeting.
 10. Lee Ormiston said that there are now 91 bills pending in Congress with the word "firearms" in them. Lee commented on the following:
 - HR1141 - Veterans' Heritage Firearms Act of 2007
 - HR1399 - District of Columbia Personal Protection Act
 - S1001 - District of Columbia Personal Protection Act
 - S376 - Law Enforcement Officers Safety Act of 2007
 - HR1022 - Assault Weapons Ben and Law Enforcement Protection Act of 2007
 - HR226 - To amend title 18 to provide a national standard in accordance with which nonresidents of a state may carry concealed firearms in the state.
 - HR861 - National Right to Carry Reciprocity Act of 2007
 - HR1791 - Fairness if Firearms Testing Act
 - S388 - same as HR226
 11. George Wright opened a discussion of a member who asked that he be allowed to conduct firearms training classes, shooting phase only, at any time he wished despite scheduled activities.
 11. Tom Rodriguez was not present to discuss the Civic League.
 12. George Wright reported that the casualty insurance is still with the NRA and will be active until next August.
 13. Denise Henry read the names of those members who are currently on the ballot for the board of directors for 2008.

14. George Wright broached the subject of an alarm system for the club. The cost would be \$700 to install and \$40 per month for the service. After a discussion, a motion was made the not have an alarm system. The motion passed unanimously.
 15. George Wright said that there will four applications for new members to consider at the next general meeting.
 16. Lee Ormiston made a motion to grant life membership to Bill Bierbach for the numerous times he made himself available to work for the club. The motion passed unanimously.
 17. George Wright said that a group from the Colorado School of Mines wished to use the range for practice either as a group or as individuals. After a discussion, a committee of Art Thayer, Gary Trisdale and Chuck Towne was appointed to form a recommendation for the board to consider.
 18. George Wright introduced a discussion of sending a board member to the NRA annual meeting each year. A motion to that effect was passed unanimously.
 19. A committee of Don Shearer, Clark Calve, and Lee Ormiston was formed to update the policy for members holding firearms training classes in the facility.
 20. Gary Trisdale moved that after duly considering recommendations of adjusting current club activities, that the current activities be maintained as scheduled. The motion passed unanimously.
 21. The meeting was adjourned at 8:54 PM.
