NRA Junior Rifle Sectionals

The NRA Sectionals are major matches that are shot at several locations throughout the country. The NRA takes the results of these local matches and produces a national result bulletin. In these matches the juniors compete by age level – junior (18 – 20), intermediate junior (15-17) and sub-junior (14 and younger). Against hundreds of shooters, we won 14 individual awards, 4 team awards and teamed with 2 former members for a share of 2 more team awards. Juniors who shoot at least one match were Megan English, Conlan McGough, Ryann McGough, Bobby Oberle, Joe Oberle, Tim Sherry, Chiara Trisdale, and Samantha Trisdale. They were joined by former members Taylor Beard and Scott Franz.

In the 3-position smallbore match, Tim was the 3rd subjunior, Chiara was 6th subjunior and Megan was the 14th intermediate junior. The 2nd junior team was won by Megan, Tim, Scott and Taylor.

In the 4-position smallbore match, Tim was the 1st subjunior and Scott was the 11 intermediate junior. Bobby, Megan, Tim and Sam were the National Intermediate Junior Team Champions.

In the precision 3-position air rifle match, Scott won the Gold Medal, Taylor won the Bronze Medal, Tim was the National Subjunior Champion, Conlan was 8th subjunior, Sam was the 19th intermediate junior and Ryann was 3rd junior. Bobby, Chiara, Sam and Tim were the 2nd intermediate junior team.

The International Air Rifle match was our best. Chiara was the 2nd subjunior, Tim was the 3rd subjunior, Conlan was the 12th subjunior, Scott was the 10th intermediate junior, Sam was the 15th intermediate junior, and Ryann was the 4th junior. The team of Ryann, Sam and Tim were the 1st junior team (missing the National Championship by only 3 points); Megan, Scott and Taylor were the 3rd junior team; and Bobby, Chiara and Conlan were the 4th intermediate junior team.

2007 National Junior Olympic 3-P Rifle Championship

Taylor Beard, Scott Franz, Tim Sherry and Samantha Trisdale were the 3rd place team at the 2007 National Junior Olympic 3-P Rifle Championship in Bowling Green Kentucky.

1. The meeting was called to order by George Wright at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the U. S. of A.
3. The minutes to the last board meeting were approved as published.
4. Clark Calve is holding one new member access card pending the new member taking the safety course.
5. Tom Thrush is still trying to sell the old Corby system on E-bay.
6. Art Thayer has received a check from the NRA for NRA membership signups.

 8. Chuck Towne reported that the loose receptacles for the jumpers for the turning targets have been replaced and all targets turn properly at both distances.
 9. A member was in front of the board to explain numerous hits on the wall of the rifle tube. The member had two guests, a father and a son, who both fired an iron sight rifle from the crutch at 30 yards with no problems. After moving to 100 yards, the son fired with no problems. The father fired some 12 rounds or so with no hits on target. The member called a halt to the shooting, walked down range to find hits in the tube wall. He entered the damage under his name in the log book and contacted George Wright. After a discussion, the board decided to ask the member and the father to undergo a session with Art Thayer to instruct the father on how to shoot an iron sighted rifle.
 10. George Wright reported that the Civic League is still pending.
 11. Lee Eihausen reported that he has signed the latest tax form.
 12. George Wright reported that the NRA insurance premium is due in November for \$3700. He said that he has found an insurance company that can offer the same coverage as is current at a lower premium.
 13. George Wright said that the pistol winter league will run from October 22, 2007 through March 31, 2008.
 14. George Wright said that the pistol class for member wives will be September 9th at 9 AM in the east range.
 15. George Wright will contact Kim to take care of the weeds.
 16. The board discussed whether to put in air conditioning in the tube.
 17. Lee Ormiston reported that the neighbor to the east has donated the east 30 feet of the property bordering on Dayton to Aurora.
 18. The meeting was adjourned at 7:46 PM.
