## **National Champions**

The National results of the NRA Sectionals are in and our shooters did very well. To list all of the awards would take too long. If I counted correctly, Dustin Chesebro, Megan English, Bobby Oberle, Tim Sherry and Samantha Trisdale won a total of 27 individual awards. It is 28, if you include the 1<sup>st</sup> Master Award that former Cherry Creek Junior Aaron Routh (Dennis Fluman's grandson) won in the 4-Position Open Sectional. Instead of listing all of them, I thought I would hit the major ones. Megan English is the **National Champion** in the Open International Air Rifle and took the **National Bronze** in Junior Air Rifle. Dustin Chesebro won the **National Silver** medal in Junior Air Rifle.

In the team matches, Dustin Chesebro, Megan English, Bobby Oberle, Tim Sherry, Chiara Trisdale and Samantha Trisdale, in various combinations, won 10 team awards. Bobby, Dustin and Megan were the **National Champions** in Junior Air Rifle; Dustin, Megan, Sam and Tim were the **National Champions** in 3-position Air Rifle; and Megan, Sam and Tim were **2<sup>nd</sup> National Team** in Open International Air Rifle.

1. The meeting was called to order by George Wright at 7:01 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.
2. The minutes to the last general meeting were approved.
3. Correspondence received was a notice from the Whittington Center announcing Founders Days on August 28-31.

7. Lee Ormiston reported that two senators asked the Department of the Interior to extend the period for comments concerning allowing firearms in National Parks and Wildlife Refuges.
8. Bill Collins said that the web site is up and running and that users must log in.
9. George Wright said that Curt Lackey is modifying an AC unit to two phase before installing it in the rifle tube.
10. George Wright reported that Arapahoe County has said that the club property has a noxious weed that needs to be sprayed. The weeds may require two sprayings.

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11. Lee Eihausen said that a place is needed in the vault for storing important documents.
  12. Don Eyser said that July 19 is work party day and that there is a back log of work that needs to be done.
  13. George Wright read the applications for membership. Each applicant talked of their interest in the club and all were accepted into the club by unanimous vote. The new members are: Thomas Funk, Glenn Sakamoto, and Jay Zimmerman.
  14. The meeting was adjourned at 7:31 PM.

**July 25, 2008**

1. The meeting was called to order by George Wright at 7:01 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the U. S. of A.
2. The minutes to the last board meeting were approved as published.
3. Don Shearer reported having an articles of his published in the "One Good Shot" magazine.
4. Clark Calve is holding three new member's cards pending their taking the safety course.
5. Denice Henry said that the newsletter is coming along fine.
6. Lee Eihausen said that about 90% of the membership are not doing their work bond.
7. Bill Collins reported that about 50 members have logged onto the revised web site.
8. Lee Ormiston said that the dead line for comments to the Department of the Interior's question of allowing firearms on public lands is August 8. Lee reported that thefts in National Forests have increased.
9. Gary Trisdale reported that the Juniors did well at a match in Georgia.
10. Curt Lackey had some questions about the installation of an A/C unit for the shooting area of the rifle tube.
11. George Wright said that the camera system will be modified to allow monitoring of the facility from the monitor's home.
12. Don Shearer said that the business plan study is on hold.

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13. There was no report on the study for NRA grants.
  14. Gary Trisdale said that the club rules allow the loaning of the club's M-1 with ammunition to members who would use that rifle in an approved match.
  15. A motion was made and passed to allow practice sessions for disabled veterans to shoot air guns on the third Friday of each month from 7 until 9 PM starting in August. Shooters will have to sign waivers. Phil can be reached on 303 934-8525.
  16. George Wright said that there are new three applicants for membership.
  17. Lee Eihausen said that he has signed only 37 work bond refund checks so far this year. There has been only one worker at the last two work parties. Several proposals were discussed including raising the work bond to \$100, cancel the December work party to force members to get their work in earlier in the year, or require members to work when their name comes up on the roster. After much discussion, a committee of Towne, Ormiston, and Collins was formed to come up with a recommendation.
  18. The meeting was adjourned at 8:22 PM.

Several members adjourned to a local restaurant for food, drink and conversation.
