CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB GENERAL MEETING MINUTES June 13, 2008

1. The meeting was called to order by George Wright at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.
2. The minutes to the last general meeting were approved.
3. Correspondence received was the annual report from the Whittington Center.
4. Gary Trisdale said that some the Juniors would be going to Ft. Benning later this month and that the sectional results are out and will be posted in the newsletter.
5. Lee Eihausen reported that the treasury is sound.
6. Lee Ormiston said that June 30 will be the last day on which to comment to your congressmen on the new rules for carrying firearms in National Parks. You should address your comments to the Department of the Interior. Nationally, there are 131 bills pending with the work "firearms" in them. Thirty of them seems to be OK to the pro-gunners, the rest are bad.
7. Don Eyser reported that lane 2's 25 yard stop micro switch is bad.
8. Art Thayer sent out the newsletter via e-mail...three came back.

9. Bill Collins reported that efforts are continuing to find leaders for the Monday night pistol winter league.
 10. Don Shearer reported attending the April 16-18 NRA Annual Meeting where he attended sessions on clubs and associations. Don spent considerable time with NRA cadre discussing the possibility of obtaining a grant. The NRA does give out numerous small grants of up to \$5,000. Don gave some examples of past club projects which may have qualified for a grant.
 11. Lee Ormiston attended sessions at the NRA Annual Meeting by the NRA-ILA on how to influence pro-gunners to get out and vote.
 12. George Wright read the applications for membership. Each applicant talked of their interest in the club and all were accepted into the club by unanimous vote. The new members are: David Rice, Edward Sherry, Conrad Holland, Ronald Rosenberg, Justin Everett, Carlos Dominick and George Sullivan.
 13. Art Thayer talked about the rules to get qualified for using the rifle tube.
 14. The meeting was adjourned at 7:39 PM.

1. The meeting was called to order by George Wright at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the U. S. of A.
2. The minutes to the last board meeting were approved as published.
3. Denise Henry said things are under control with the newsletter.
4. Lee Ormiston commented on the Supreme Court decision on Washington DC VS. Keller which upheld the right to keep defend one's property.
5. Clark Calve is holding two new member's cards pending their taking the safety course.
6. Lee Eihausen reported that the treasury is healthy.
7. The secretary said that he would report for the committee on waivers for active military personnel who would join the club.
8. Bill Collins will have the web site up to par by July 16.

9. The secretary discussed waivers for membership for active military servicemen. A motion was made to accept to proposal which waives the initiation fee, the work bond and half of the membership fee. The board discussed the cost of the background check and decided that it was a separate issue. The proposal passed on a 5 to 2 vote.

 11. Don Shearer proposed creating a committee to gain an understanding of obtaining grants from the NRA and to compose documentation requesting NRA grant(s). Don further proposed forming a committee to address plans for major capital improvements. Also, create a committee to establish a club business plan. And lastly, to establish a plan to create interaction with the community. Don and Tom Rodriquez and two other members will be on the committee for the first two items and the secretary will research the requirements for NRA grants.
 12. George Wright said that there are four applicants for membership and that there are currently 515 club members.
 13. Phil Scholl asked for range time on the third Friday evening of the month for disabled veterans. The board will consider the request and give an answer at the July board meeting.
 14. The meeting was adjourned at 8:09 PM.
