Junior Olympic Shooting Championships

Once a year, the top juniors in the country are invited to the Olympic Training Center to shoot a head-to-head match to determine the national champions. This year, we had 5 shooters invited, Dustin Chesebro, Megan English, Tim Sherry, Chiara Trisdale and Samantha Trisdale. Our shooters had some amazing performances.

In women's air rifle, Megan ended up in 6^{th} place overall and Samantha was 6^{th} in her age group. In women's 3-position smallbore, Megan was 5^{th} overall and shot the highest score in the 10 shot "finals" round where she passed 3 other shooters; and Samantha was 5^{th} in her age group.

In men's air rifle, Dustin was 4th overall and shot the highest score in the final round; and Tim Sherry took the Silver medal for his age group. In men's prone, Tim Sherry was 5th in his age group. In men's 3-position smallbore, Dustin was 9th overall, just missing the 10 shot "finals"; and Tim was 5th in his age group.

Olympic Trials for Smallbore

The Olympic Trials for smallbore will be held in May. We plan on taking 5 juniors to this match, including Dustin Chesebro, Megan English, Bobby Oberle Chiara Trisdale and Samantha Trisdale. Everyone has been working hard and is very excited. For the men, everyone is competing for the 1 open slot in each of prone and 3-position. In smallbore, the women are competing for 2 open slots in 3-positions.

- 4. Clark Calve is holding four older new membership cards and the cards for tonight's new members pending their taking the safety course.
- 5. Denise Henry reported that the newsletter is on schedule.

- 11. Glen Walls said that a janitor is needed for August. Glen said that a thieving member stole some garbage bags.
- 12. George Wright said that Lee Eihausen has put up green boxes in the ranges with various lengths of target sticks in them. Now, no one has an excuse for not placing their target at the proper height to keep from shooting into the overhead or the floor. After you use them, please put them back in the green boxes.

- 15. George Wright asked that all newsletter input be sent to him.
