4. Clark Calve reported holding eleven new member access cards pending them taking the safety course.
5. Gary Trisdale reported that the Junior's first match of the season will be at the Olympic Training Center and that four new shooters will accompany the rest of the team.

6. Denise Henry said that the newsletter is coming along nicely.
7. Don Eyser said that there was one volunteer at the last work party.
8. Lee Eihausen reported that all bills were paid and that the club's bank sent a letter to not worry.
9. Lee Ormiston said that the campaigns are still running stupid.
10. Bill Collins reported that the new rewrite of the membership booklets should be ready next week.
11. Art Thayer said that the next tube qualification would be next Friday evening.
12. Clark Calve and Don Eyser represented the club in honoring Howard Glasier for his many years of dedication to the club. Howard received an engraved plaque and some gift certificates.
13. George Wright read the applications for membership. Each applicant talked of their interest in the club and all were accepted into the club by unanimous vote. CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING October 31, 2008

Attendees: Towne, Wright, Calve, Eihausen, Shearer, Collins, Thayer, the Henry's, Ormiston, Eyser and several interested members.

1. The meeting was called to order by George Wright at 6:59 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. The minutes to the last board meeting were approved as published.
3. Correspondence was a request to join the Trailblazers from the Whittington Center and an application from the NRA to submit the club for NRA club awards.
4. Don Shearer said that an article of his has been published in the "One Good Shot" magazine.
5. Clark Calve is holding seven new member's cards pending their taking the safety course.
6. Bill Collins reported receiving 500 copies of the membership booklet from the printers.
7. Don Eyser reported having a good turn out at the last work party. The work party cleaned out the lead from the backstop which will be picked up by salvage next week.
8. Lee Ormiston asked everyone to get out and vote and that the legislatures have not done anything anti-gun since the last report.

9. Denise Henry had a question about the calendar for the newsletter which was answered.
10. Lee Eihausen said that eight work bond refunds have been paid out.
11. Don Shearer said that plans for the clubs future should be ready for review by the next board meeting.
12. Denise Henry reported having twelve candidates on the slate for the 2009 board of directors. Thirteen are needed as a minimum.
13. Lee Ormiston reported receiving an engineering report of the roof repair/replacement. Clark Calve is getting estimates to get the job done.
14. George Wright said that the range heating systems are inoperative. Per the new work bond policy, the Maintenance Coordinator has the authority to go outside the club to get the system(s) fixed.
15. George Wright said that there are six applications for membership pending.
16. Don Shearer reported on the disabled Veterans shoot. Five shooters, all in wheel chairs, shot up almost a full brick of ammunition and had a ball.
17. George Wright said that a member asked about the smoking policy in the range. It is not allowed. The member was advised to ask the smoker to put it out politely.
18. Don Shearer said that he has received an e-mail concerning the Civic League. A report will be made next board meeting.
19. Don Shearer said that a new lead emissions standard has been issued by the government which is one tenth of the previous standard. Don said that the club will have no problem meeting the new standard.
20. The meeting was adjourned at 7:38 PM.

CCGC WORK BOND/PARTY POLICY

1. Each non-exempt member will pay a work bond of \$50 per year which will be refunded for attending one work party in that year. Exempt members are life, emeritus, associate, collegiate, junior, and board members.
2. Each year, the membership shall be polled to determine whether they will attend a work party. A list will be prepared identifying those willing to work together with ways of contacting them.
3. Work parties will be scheduled on the third Saturday of each month from 8 AM until noon. The range will be closed in the area where the work is being done.
4. Workers will be selected based on the first letter of their last name with the worker list divided into eleven equal parts (as practicable). December will be reserved for makeup. Workers may work other months at their convenience.
5. Volunteers are welcome at any work party.
6. The Maintenance Coordinator will identify the work to be performed at the next work party in time to be announced at the board meeting prior to the work party date. The work item(s) will be published in the newsletter, on the web site and posted in the bulletin board.
7. Workers will be credited for four hours of work should the work party be completed prior to four hours.

8. The work party may become a party at the club's expense.
9. A member may volunteer to be responsible for a system/item.
10. Work items requiring no supervision and are of a size for one or two people should be posted.
11. Any member may work more than one work party and be compensated for each work party worked up to a maximum of seven work parties.
12. Work items outside the scope of a work party will be referred to the Board of Directors for resolution.
13. In the event an insufficient number of workers result in not getting the work done, the Maintenance Coordinator has the authority to solicit other members first or outside vendors second to get the work done. The cap on outside vendors is \$1,000 per task.
14. In the event an insufficient number of workers results in not getting necessary work done, the Maintenance Coordinator may shut down the range(s) until the necessary work is done.
