CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB GENERAL MEETING MINUTES  
September 12, 2008

1. The meeting was called to order by George Wright at 6:59 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.
2. The minutes to the last general meeting were approved.
3. Correspondence was a letter to join the NRA and a letter from the Whittington Center about matching grant money.
4. Clark Calve reported holding two new member access cards pending them taking the safety course.
5. Curt Lackey reported that he is obtaining bids on new HVAC equipment for the range.
6. Don Eyser reported that the next work party will be on September 20.
7. Lee Eihausen reported paying the normal monthly bills, receiving income from new members and guest fees and that the club passed the fire inspection.
8. Bill Collins said that the pistol Winter league would start on October 20 and that a meeting was held to delegate responsibility for the league.
9. Gary Trisdale reported several Juniors have joined the Junior club this season.
10. Art Thayer said that the next rifle tube qualification would be on September 19. There is a sign up sheet on the door to the rifle tube.
11. Chuck Towne reported that he has checked the turning capability of the target carriers and all twenty work at both 50 foot and 25 yards. One receptacle had to be replaced because it had been shot.
12. George Wright read the applications for membership. Each applicant talked of their interest in the club and all were accepted into the club by unanimous vote. The new members are: Susy Walmsley, Leonard Walmsley, Richard Rainesalo, and Michael Esposito.
13. George Wright reported on the results of the work party questionnaire. Of the 37 responses, 23 will work, 4 by the first letter of their last name. Fifteen indicated that they had special skills.
14. George Wright opened a discussion whether to send a donation to the Whittington Center. The club has already sent a contribution this year. A motion was made to not send a donation which passed.
15. The meeting was adjourned at 7:27 PM.

CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING  
September 26, 2008

Attendees: Towne, Collins, Eihausen, Calve, Bierbach, Trisdale, Thayer, the Henry's, Eyser, Ormiston, Lackey and several interested members.

1. The meeting was called to order by Bill Collins at 7:02 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. The minutes to the last board meeting were approved as published.
3. Bill Collins reported that the web site is healthy.
4. Clark Calve is holding six new member's cards pending their taking the safety course.
5. Denice Henry said that the newsletter is coming along fine.
6. Don Eyser reported having six workers at the last work party. The vents in the roof were painted. Don thinks that the good turnout of workers was because of the notice in the newsletter. A suggestion was made to place the notice on page one of the newsletter.
7. Gary Trisdale said that the Juniors season will start in a couple of weeks and that he has added five new kids to the Juniors club. Two kids with their Dads have joined the Winter League. Don Eyser thanked Gary for the instruction Don and his group received.
8. Lee Ormiston said that nothing of significance has occurred in the legislatures, both state wise and nationally.
9. Curt Lackey said that he is pricing HVAC systems and assessing the options available for improving heating and air conditioning.
10. Lee Eihausen reported paying five work bond refunds plus the normal monthly bills.
11. Bill Bierbach reported that there are four applications pending.
12. The secretary discussed the Work Bond/Party policy developed by the committee. After a discussion and two suggested changes, the policy was accepted unanimously.
13. The secretary briefly discussed the NRA Grant policy.
14. Lee Ormiston reported that an engineer reviewed the range roof at a cost of \$500. A report is pending review.
15. Bill Bierbach reported that five applications have been received.
16. Curt Lackey discussed the options for improving the HVAC systems. Curt recommends two five ton units but they require three phase electricity. A converter is available for \$1,000. The required

duct work would be \$3,000. More holes will have to be cut to allow proper air flow. There is a possibility to increase the heat output of the radiant heaters in the pistol range.

17. Bill Collins moved to grant life membership to Don Eyser for his dedication and years of work. The motion passed unanimously.
18. Bill Collins said that the Winter Pistol League has asked for addition access to the vault for the equipment needed to set up the range for the League. The board approved the request.
19. Bill Collins corrected the final date for the Pistol Winter League.
20. Dates for the Winter Smallbore Winter League were approved. They will start on Wednesday evenings Oct. 1 and end March 25, 2009 from 5 until 9 PM.
21. Dates for the NRA Junior Sectionals for 2009 were approved.
22. Dates for the Juniors practice sessions for Thursday evenings for both ranges were approved. Also, the Juniors request for the east range on Wednesday evenings were approved starting April 1, 2009.
23. Dates for the Pistol 2700 matches were approved.
24. The meeting was adjourned at 7:59 PM.
