All club members were sent a packet by USPS containing the, "Member's Book," a letter signed by the President of the Club, a letter titled, "Release of Claims, Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement," and, a, "Letter of Acknowledgement and Affirmation." The last two letters must be signed and returned to the club to be filed in your membership folder. The, "Affirmation," letter, with your signature, affirms that you have read the, "Member's Book," and know the club's policies and rules. Ignorance of the rules is no excuse.

The, "Waiver," letter is dual purpose. You sign it for filing in your membership folder. Should you bring a guest to the facility to shoot, you again sign a blank copy and your guest also signs the same form. Blank forms may be found next to the gray box, just inside the second entrance door in the main room. Signed forms should be placed in the gray box.

Failure to return both the, "Waiver," and the, "Affirmation," letter, by August 21<sup>st</sup>, 2009, may result in having your access card turned off.

A class titled, "Fundamentals of Target Pistol Shooting," will be taught by Chuck Towne, a distinguished pistol shooter. The class will be at 7:00PM, Friday, August 21<sup>st</sup>, 2009, at the range and will be limited to the first twelve members to register. There will be no live firing and the instructor will provide firearms only for instructional purposes. To register, call Chuck at 303-795-3293.

The class will be based on the fundamentals as taught by the Army Marksmanship Training Unit, based on years of learning what the fundamentals mean, and based on years of experience.

## CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB GENERAL MEETING MINUTES July 10, 2009

1. The meeting was called to order by Lee Ormiston at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.
2. Two prospective new member's applications were read to the members present. Each applicant talked of his experience, interest in the club and his qualifications. The applicants are: Bob Balaban and Marc Sievers. They were accepted into the club by unanimous vote of the members present.
3. The secretary paraphrased a letter from the Division of Wildlife who is asking for volunteers to indoctrinate new people to the state on hunting in Colorado.
4. There were no corrections to the minutes as published in the newsletter.
5. There were no comments from the members present on the activities of the board or club.
6. Lee Ormiston announced that the new rewrite of the "Membership Booklet" has been mailed to each club member. Included is a waiver form and a letter of affirmation which must be signed and returned.
7. George Henry said that the newsletter is on schedule.
8. Don Eyser said that the next work party would be on July 18 and that the work would be raking lead out of the backstop. Don asked that any member who does any work in the facility to call him to obtain credit. Don said that his computer has been down and that the June and July newsletters have been recently mailed.
9. Mike Hopkins said that arrangements are being made to visit the Boulder Police Department range to see how the laminar air flow in their range is obtained.
10. Clark Calve is holding eleven access cards of new members pending them taking the safety course.
11. Ron Rosenberg said that the web site has been updated to provide links to the newly rewritten application, release form and letter of affirmation.
12. Lee Eihausen said that all bills have been paid.

13. Bill Bierbach reported that several members have been qualified for the tube. Tube qualification classes are scheduled on the third Friday of each month. There are nine more applications to be considered tonight.
14. Prospective new member's applications were read to the members present. Each applicant talked of his experience, interest in the club and his qualifications. The applicants are: Americo Almada, Peggy Lea Bradfor, Jemery Kong, Vladislav Lozinskiy, Edward Richard, Deavin DeLaRosa (Jr.), Ian Garrett (Mil), Diana Nelson, and Steven Zimmerman. All were accepted by unanimous vote of the members present.
15. A discussion on the handling of the returned waiver and letter of affirmation followed.
16. Don Shearer complimented the board for its efforts to update the administrative documents of the club and in renovating the HVAC system and repairing the leaking roof.
17. The secretary admonished the new members to read the "Green Book" and also the newsletter. Not knowing the rules and policies of the club is no excuse.
18. The general meeting was adjourned at 7:36 PM.

## **CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING**

July 31, 2009

Attendees: Towne, Eihausen, Bierbach, Rosenberg, Hopkins, Calve, Trisdale, Ormiston, Shearer, Henry, and Johnston and several interested members.

1. The meeting was called to order by Lee Ormiston at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. Clark Calve said that he is holding nine membership cards pending the members taking the safety course.
3. Ron Rosenberg said that the club's answering machine is full. Clark Calve will take the responsibility of clearing and maintaining the answering machine.
4. Don Shearer reported that the Veterans Administration's director feels that the club is unsafe for veterans to shoot in the facility and will not support a program for the veterans to shoot. A group visited the Boulder Police Department range to take note of their ventilation system. In our range, there is a safety issue with the bullet hitting the T-bars in the ceiling and ricocheting back to the shooter. Also discussed was obtaining plates to cover the back wall.

5. Mike Hopkins said that the draft plans for the HVAC system should be available Wednesday for review. Mike reported that the bill to honor concealed carry permits in other states failed to pass.
6. Don Eyser said that the last work party did not rake lead from the back stop but instead did other projects.
7. George Henry reported that the newsletter is on schedule and that any articles to be added should be submitted.
8. Lee Eihausen said that the club has club patches for sale at \$5 each.
9. Gary Trisdale said that the Aurora Sentinel newspaper had an article about Samantha Trisdale's successes in at Ft. Benning, Georgia.
10. Bill Bierbach reported that four members qualified for the tube.
11. Tom Rodriguez reported on the rules infractions of a member's guest who used a short target holder stick such that she was placing shots on the number plate of the carrier. The member acknowledged the infraction.
12. Lee Ormiston said that the tax reports used to be six pages in length but the IRS decided to be more critical with non-profit organizations. Due to recent rulings, the IRS report now runs to 21 pages. Tom Rodriguez said that the club must establish policies for conflict of interest, for whistle blowers and for record retention in order to comply with IRS rulings. A motion to accept the submitted policies passed unanimously.
13. Gary Trisdale said that it has been club policy to reimburse part of the travel expenses for the Juniors.
14. The board approved the dates of club activities for 2010 for the pin shooters, for the Juniors, and for the Small Bore Winter League.
15. The Juniors were applauded for their work at cleaning up the facility periodically. The Juniors receive work bond funds for their work.
16. A question was raised concerning range rent fees for the club activities. A committee of Rodriguez, Rosenberg, Towne and Walls was formed to formulate a policy.
17. A question was raised concerning whether all club members or whether only members 19 years or older should be NRA members. The

decision was that **ALL** members must be NRA members including Juniors.

18. The membership committee reported that the Member Welcome letter and the Application have been rewritten and are acceptable.
19. Bill Bierbach reported that not all of the letters of Affirmation and Waiver forms have been returned. Reminder letters or e-mails will be sent with a dead line of August 21 before access cards are turned off.
20. Gay Trisdale will be writing up a Waiver Form for the Juniors.
21. A working group for the HVAC and ventilation system was formed of Bierbach, Hopkins, Shearer, Towne and Trisdale.
22. Glen Walls will obtain documentation on questions arising from the back ground checks of new applicants.
23. The board ruled on the member who shot the carrier number plate; to suspend his access pending his retaking the safety check with Clark Calve and to not allow him to bring in guests.
24. Clark Calve said that the cost of additional lighting for the Juniors at 33 feet would run about \$3,000.
25. The meeting was adjourned at 9:16 PM.
