### CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB GENERAL MEETING MINUTES December 12, 2008

- 1. The meeting was called to order by George Wright at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.
- 2. The minutes to the last general meeting were approved.
- 3. Don Shearer said that he had received an e-mail concerning the "Ammunition Accountability Act.
- 4. Clark Calve reported holding six new member access cards pending them taking the safety course.
- 5. Denise Henry said that the newsletter is on schedule.
- 6. Gary Trisdale displayed a large special flag which acknowledges the Juniors successes.
- 7. Lee Eihausen reported that the renewals are still coming in.
- 8. The new membership custodian in training said the he had not been able to make contact with five member as they haven't answered their phone messages thus they have not received the December newsletter.
- 9. Lee Ormiston said that there are 154 bills pending with the word "firearms" in them. Lee asked the membership to read the bills and then contact their congressmen to express their thoughts on the offensive bills.
- 10. Bill Bierbach reporting for Curt Lackey that Curt will be installing larger heater units in the radiant heaters this weekend. Bill said that the current membership is 552 counting all categories.
- 11. Art Thayer said that the next tube qualification session will be on December 19 at 6:30 PM.

- 12. Den Eyser said that the next work party would be on December 20. The work will include replacing the supports for the target carrier rails.
- 13. George Wright said that he is transferring the maintenance of the clubs data base to Chuck Towne.
- 14. George Wright said that the Ammunition Accountability Act is being proposed in eighteen states but not in Colorado (yet). The act requires manufactures to stamp bullet cases and projectiles with a number for traceability. Buyers will not be able to purchase unstamped bullets after 2009 and citizens will not be allowed to possess unstamped bullets after 2011. Again, send letters.
- 15. George Wright read the one new application for membership. The applicant talked of his interest in the club and was accepted into the club by unanimous vote. The new member is Douglas Work.
- 16. Denise Henry conducted the election for the 2009 Board of Directors. Each candidate stated the reason(s) for wanting to be on the board. The vote was taken by ballot and those elected are: Clark Calve, Lee Eihausen, George Henry, Curt Lackey, Lee Ormiston, Don Shearer, Gary Trisdale, Chuck Towne, Mike Hopkins, Don Eyser, Bill Bierbach, Ron Rosenberg, and Warren Johnston.
- 17. Janitors are needed for next year. Sign up soon to get the month you wish to work.
- 18. The meeting was adjourned at 7:52 PM.

#### CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

December 26, 2008

- 1. The meeting was called to order by George Wright at 7 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
- 2. The minutes to the last board meeting were approved as published.
- 3. Correspondence was a letter from the NRA about becoming a NRA Gold Metal Club by maintaining 100% NRA club members among other requirements.
- 4. Clark Calve is holding four new members cards pending their taking the safety course.

- 5. Don Eyser reported that there was a good turn out for the last work party and a lot was accomplished. The door lock between ranges is in for repair.
- 6. Denise Henry said that the newsletter is on schedule.
- 7. Lee Eihausen reported receiving 3 to 4 renewal notices per day.
- 8. Bill Bierbach said that there are several applications for membership pending.
- 9. Lee Ormiston said that there have been no legislative activity concerning firearms lately.
- 10. George Wright said that Grover Morash has requested Emeritus status.
- 11. George Wright reported receiving many comments about the recent increase in the quest fee.
- 12. Denise Henry conducted the election of officers for the 2009 Board of Directors. Lee Ormiston was elected President; Don Shearer, Vice President; Chuck Towne, Secretary; and Lee Eihausen, Treasurer.
- 13. The new President, Lee Ormiston, chaired the meeting from this point.
- 14. The Board and members present gave a huge "Thank You" to George Wright and Art Thayer for their service to the club.
- 15. The board discussed the rules infractions of a member who was observed firing from in front of the firing line, firing while moving, firing from a holster, failing to supervise his guest, and lying to the board. Formal letters will be written to the member explaining the infractions and his right of appeal.
- 16. The board discussed the member who fired two shots from a 223 rifle into the backstop thereby damaging the metal plates. Again, a formal letter will be written.
- 17. The board discussed a recommendation that members over 70 year old be exempt of their work bond. A motion to that effect was made and seconded. An amendment was made to grant the recommendation by petition to the board. The amendment and the motion were both passed.
- 18. Don Shearer handed out a draft of the business plan for the club for the board to review prior to the next board meeting and to send any comments to Don.

- 19. The board discussed screening of applicants based on the results of the background check. A motion to establish a policy failed to pass. A motion to authorize the Membership Coordinator to bring items of concern to the attention of the board passed.
- 20. Don Shearer said that questions concerning the Civic League need to be resolved.
- 21. Denise raised a question about placing training sessions on the calendar and bringing the activity to the attention of the board.
- 22. Appointments for the various jobs were made. The jobs as listed in the newsletter were maintained with the following changes. Legislative, Hopkins; Membership Coordinators, Bierbach and Towne; Website manager, Rosenberg; Phone message administer, Rosenberg; Tube qualification instructors, Bierbach and Kwon; NRA coordinator, Hopkins; and Training class coordinator, Tom Rodriguez.
- 23. Curt Lackey gave an update on the work on the radiant heaters.
- 24. Clark Calve moved to nominate Jim Schwartz for life membership for his long service for the club.
- 25. Clark Calve said that it is the responsibility of each member to question any unsafe practice observed and to notify a member of the board immediately of such infractions.
- 26. The meeting was adjourned at 9:15M.
