## **National Open Sectional Results**

Every spring, we shoot 2 types of rifle sectionals – Open (anyone can shoot) and Junior (only those under 21 can shoot). The results from our local sectional are sent to the NRA and combined with the results shot in other states to determine national rankings. The junior sectionals consist of air rifle (standing), 3-position air rifle, 3-position smallbore, and 4-position smallbore. The competition is by age group – subjunior (SJ) (14 and younger), intermediate junior (IJ) (15-17) and junior (JR) (18 – 20).

We did well this year, with 3 of our junior shooters winning national individual awards along with 3 of our teams winning national awards. Dustin Chesebro was 5<sup>th</sup> JR (10<sup>th</sup> overall) in 4-position smallbore, 5<sup>th</sup> JR in 3-position air rifle, and 16<sup>th</sup> JR in air rifle. Bobby Oberle was 8<sup>th</sup> JR in 3-position smallbore.

Samantha Trisdale was 1<sup>st</sup> IJ (5<sup>th</sup> overall) in 3-position air, 4<sup>th</sup> IJ in 4-position smallbore, 7<sup>th</sup> IJ in 3-position smallbore and 8<sup>th</sup> IJ in air rifle.

The team of Bobby Oberle, Tim Sherry, Chiara Trisdale and Samantha Trisdale was 3<sup>rd</sup> Junior in 4-position smallbore and 5<sup>th</sup> Junior in 3-position smallbore. The team of Josh Davis court, Bobby Oberle, Tim Sherry and Samantha Trisdale was 5<sup>th</sup> Junior in 3-position air rifle.

### **USA Shooting National Championships**

We had 4 juniors attend the USA Shooting National Championships at Fort Benning, Georgia. They were Dustin Chesebro, Shanna Fiorino, Tim Sherry and Samantha Trisdale. I had forgotten how hot it is in Georgia in June. Mid-afternoon it was 95 – 100, with very high humidity. The 50 meter smallbore range is a unique experience. The targets are outside, but the shooters are inside a long metal building with a door for each firing point (there are 79 firing points). Inside the building is hotter than it is outside and there is rarely a breeze that makes it into the building. In all of this, the rifle shooters put on a sweater and heavy canvas shooting clothes. This year, one young woman was taken to the hospital by ambulance due to the heat.

Dustin Chesebro was 6<sup>th</sup> Junior (age 20 and younger) in air rifle and 8<sup>th</sup> Junior in 3-position smallbore. Shanna Fiorino was 7<sup>th</sup> Junior in air rifle. Tim Sherry was 7<sup>th</sup> in his age group in prone, 7<sup>th</sup> in his age group in air and 8<sup>th</sup> in his age group in 3-position smallbore. Samantha Trisdale was 7<sup>th</sup> Junior in 3-position smallbore and 2<sup>nd</sup> Junior (6<sup>th</sup> overall) in air rifle. As a result of her 2<sup>nd</sup> Junior finish in air rifle, Samantha earned a spot on the USA Shooting National Junior Team for rifle. Samantha is the 3<sup>rd</sup> of our Juniors to earn this honor in the past 2 years. The others are Dustin Chesebro and Megan English.

## CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

June 12, 2009

1. The meeting was called to order by Lee Ormiston at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.
2. Don Shearer and Gary Trisdale were excused from the meeting
3. The minutes as published in the newsletter were accepted.
4. The secretary apologized for suggesting that all members be required to be registered to vote. He said that a better word than “required” is “encouraged”.
5. Tom Rodriguez gave a thank you to the son-in-law of the secretary who saved the club approximately \$450 for lodging in Phoenix during the NRA annual meeting.

6. The secretary read a letter from Rick Wilson who thanked the secretary for mentioning the Junior shooter's program and how it will benefit his son who is starting at West Point.
7. Clark Calve is holding seven access cards of new members pending them taking the safety course.
8. Ron Rosenberg said that he would place information from members on the club's web site.
9. Mike Hopkins said that there are 66 bills pending with the word "firearms" in them. HR 2159 and HR 45 are particularly bad. Mike handed out a paper detailing proposals for a new HVAC unit and for roofing repair. The board will review the paper.
10. George Henry said that the newsletter is on schedule.
11. Warren Johnston said that the next work party would be on Saturday, June 20.
12. Don Eyser asked for the use of a pickup to take pop cans to recycle.
13. Lee Eihausen said that all bills are paid.
14. Bill Bierbach reported that he has qualified two new members for use of the tube and detailed the process for getting qualified. Bill asked the work coordinator to schedule shampooing the meeting room chairs.
15. Don Eyser said that the trash bags are disappearing too fast.
16. Prospective new member's applications were read to the members present. Each applicant talked of his experience, interest in the club and his qualifications. The applicants are: Joseph Dobrusky, Daniel Burnett, Hardy Anderson, John Haien, Michael Hood, John Laughridge, Timothy Roth, and Steven Wright. All were accepted by unanimous vote of the members present.
17. The secretary admonished the new members to read the "Yellow Book" and also the newsletter. Not knowing the rules and policies of the club is no excuse.
18. The meeting was recessed for a special board meeting.
19. The general meeting was reconvened and then adjourned at 8:14 PM.

## **CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING**

June 26, 2009

Attendees: Towne, Eihausen, Calve, Bierbach, Rosenberg, Shearer, Ormiston, Hopkins, Henry, Rodriguez, Trisdale, Eyser, Lackey and several interested members.

1. The meeting was called to order by Lee Ormiston at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. The secretary read a letter from a member who was called before the board to discuss rules infractions. The letter was his resignation from the club.
3. Clark Calve said that he is holding ten membership cards pending the members taking the safety course.
4. Ron Rosenberg said that he would accept items to be placed on the club's web site from club members.
5. George Henry reported that the newsletter is on schedule.
6. Don Eyser said that some drainage down spouts need repair. Clark Calve said that he would take care of the problem.
7. Bill Bierbach reported that there are approximately twelve new applications pending.
8. Curt Lackey said that he came in fourth at the Nationals at Ft. Benning.
9. Mike Hopkins handed out the latest printing of the "Yellow Book" and said that he feels that it is complete with all of the submitted changes.
10. Lee Ormiston handed out copies of a "Presidents Letter" with a Letter of Affirmation and a Release of Claims letter. All three letters will be sent to the membership for their signature. They will also be listed on the web site and in the newsletter. Waivers are required by the insurance company in order to get better coverage and lower rates. A parent may sign for their Juniors. Civilians shooting in club activities will also be asked to sign the waivers. The signed waivers must be returned within 21 days.
11. Don Shearer reported that the Veterans Administration Rehabilitation program appears to be dead. The director of VA programs feels that the club is not safe for this type of activity for the veterans. The board consensus is to talk to the program's director, or failing a turn around, her boss.
12. Ron Rosenberg reported that the application has been reviewed and rewritten. A change will be added to require each new member to read the policies and rules sections of the "Yellow Book" as a minimum and attest to this with his signature prior to acceptance of his application.

13. Head of each club activity are reminded that financial reports are to be handed in to the club's treasurer prior to February 15,2010 in order to prepare the income tax report.
14. A question was raised concerning the finances of the Wednesday night Central Division smallbore activity. The item was tabled pending further review.
15. Steve Locatelli submitted match dates for the Pistol 2700 matches for the 2009-2010 season. Signed waivers will be required for all competitors. The match dates are: September 27, October 24, November 28, December 19 in 2009 and January 30, February 27, March 27, and April 24 in 2010. There will be two relays which will require the east range for the entire day. A motion to accept the match dates passed unanimously.
16. Mike Hopkins reported that a consultant from Chicago who specializes in range design requires a fee which is prohibitive for the club. The board decided to tell Hadjii Engineering to submit a design which will provide conditioned laminar air flow past shooters.
17. The meeting was adjourned at 8:38 PM.
