## **National Open Sectional Results**

Every spring, we shoot 2 types of rifle sectionals – Open (anyone can shoot) and Junior (only those under 21 can shoot). The results from our local sectional are sent to the NRA and combined with the results shot in other states to determine national rankings. The open sectionals consist of International Air Rifle, International 3-position smallbore (no scopes on rifles), NRA Conventional smallbore (rifle scopes allowed) and 4-position smallbore. We did well this year, with 5 of our current shooters winning individual awards along with 3 of our teams winning awards. Dustin Chesebro was 5<sup>th</sup> Expert in International 3-p, 2<sup>nd</sup> Sharpshooter in 4-p, and 1<sup>st</sup> Expert in International Air Rifle. Bobby Oberle was

5<sup>th</sup> Sharpshooter in 4-p. Tim Sherry was 10<sup>th</sup> Sharpshooter in International air rifle, 10<sup>th</sup> Expert in 4-p and 8<sup>th</sup> Sharpshooter in NRA 3-p. Chiara Trisdale was 11<sup>th</sup> Sharpshooter in NRA 3-p and 9<sup>th</sup> Sharpshooter in International 3-p. Samantha Trisdale was 8<sup>th</sup> Expert in 4-p, 7<sup>th</sup> Expert in International 3-p, 4<sup>th</sup> Expert in NRA 3-p and 3<sup>rd</sup> Expert in International Air Rifle. As you might guess, several of the juniors have already received cards moving them up in classification.

Taylor Beard, a former Cherry Creek junior who is shooting at the University of Alaska – Fairbanks, was 6<sup>th</sup> Expert in International 3-p, 4<sup>th</sup> Master in NRA 3-p, and High Woman in International air rifle (2<sup>nd</sup> overall).

The team of Bobby Oberle, Tim Sherry, Chiara Trisdale and Samantha Trisdale was 2<sup>nd</sup> Expert in 4-p and 1<sup>st</sup> Expert in NRA 3-p. The team of Shanna Fiorino, Bobby Oberle and Samantha Trisdale was the 2<sup>nd</sup> overall in International air rifle.

## CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB GENERAL MEETING MINUTES May 8, 2009

1. The meeting was called to order by Lee Ormiston at 5:45 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.
2. Prospective new member's applications were read to the members present. Each applicant talked of his experience, interest in the club and his qualifications. The applicants are: Justin Cohen, Scott Friedman, Daniel Peckman, Joshua Rubin, Ronald Rubin, and Mikhail Belov. All the applicants were accepted into the club by unanimous vote of the members present.
3. The minutes of the last meetings were approved as published.
4. The meeting was opened for member comments. One member asked what the proper length of the target stick should be. Regardless of the length, the target should be placed such that the

bullet strikes the backstop. This may mean using a piece of cardboard in order to get the target at the correct height.

5. Correspondence received was a letter from a member who had an accidental shot from a pistol. He was not sure where the shot went, reported the incident and accepted responsibility for any damage.
6. An e-mail was received announcing the passing of long time member Patrick Crotty.
7. A late applicant was accepted into the club by unanimous vote of the members present. The new member is Joshua Sharf.
8. Clark Calve reported holding many cards of new members pending their taking the safety indoctrination course.
9. Lee Eihausen reported that the club is out of club patches. A motion was made and passed to authorize Lee to investigate costs.
10. George Henry reported that the newsletter is on schedule.
11. Ron Rosenberg said that he would place information from members on the club's web site. Ron is learning the new video system and will complete setting it up. A motion to this effect was made and passed.
12. Don Eyser said that the next work party would be on May 16 and that he received \$572.40 for the salvaged lead.
13. Bill Bierbach talked about a member who said that he paid his dues but that no record of this can be found. The access card of this member will be turned off. Bill said that he has selected a target size for those members who wish to qualify for shooting off hand in the rifle tube.
14. Ron Rosenberg said that he is learning the membership data base systems as back up.
15. Don Eyser discussed the steel for protection of the wall behind the backstop.
16. The meeting was temporarily adjourned for a special board meeting.
17. A second group of prospective new members were introduced and accepted into the club by unanimous vote of the members present. The new members are: Patrick Brown, Ray Baron, Leslie Green (Assoc.), James Idema, Robert Smith, Steven McElroy (Assoc.), Patrick Gordon (Coll), Sam Schroeder (Coll), Arthur Thorne IV (Coll), Greg Hartung, John Buglovshy, and John Hargrove.
18. The meeting was adjourned at 7:39 PM.

## **CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING**

May 29, 2009

1. The meeting was called to order by Lee Ormiston at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. The secretary read a letter from the Sportsman Council asking for support in getting the Sportsman Channel added to Comcast Cable lineup. If interested, contact Alison Demulling at [ademulling@thesportsmanchannel.com](mailto:ademulling@thesportsmanchannel.com). Also received is a pamphlet on "Protecting Firing Ranges and the Environment".
3. Clark Calve said that he is holding ten membership cards pending the members taking the safety course.
4. Chuck Towne reported on the NRA annual meeting. Conclusions are that the club should organize classes on pistol and rifle fundamentals for spouses and women and classes on reloading. The club should make the December annual meeting a social affair and that the board should consider requiring all members to be registered to vote. These items were referred to a later board meeting.
5. Ron Rosenberg asked for suggestions for items to be put on the club's web site. Ron is learning the new range video system.
6. Warren Johnston reported that the next work party would be on June 20 for usual maintenance work.
7. Don Eyser said that the work parties are working on straightening the carrier rails and that the fan hatches on the roof will be painted at the next work party.
8. George Henry reported that the newsletter is on schedule.
9. Mike Hopkins reported that there are 64 bills pending which concern firearms. Mike asked the board members to review the rewrite of the "Yellow Book".
10. Gary Trisdale said that one Junior team placed second in the National Open Sectional. One Cherry Creek alumni has graduated from West Point.
11. Lee Eihausen reported that those members who have renewed late are paying a \$50 late fee. The shooting session for the disabled veterans is on the calendar.

12. Ron Rosenberg said that another applicant has asked for another early general meeting. The board also needs to address early meetings for the tube qualification sessions.
13. Lee Ormiston said that the board members need to record mileage and that they need to indicate when to have a special board meeting.
14. Tom Rodriguez said that he has contacted several firms concerning quotes for club insurance.
15. Mike Hopkins has contacted a structural engineer on loading of the roof for a new HVAC unit. The three phase electrical hookup will cost about \$13,000.
16. Don Eyser said that steel plate for the rear wall should run the full length and that a test plate should be obtained for bullet impact tests.
17. A person who was denied membership presented her case to the board. The board asked for a release to obtain documentation and that the issue would be heard at a later date.
18. Don Eyser presented a plaque in honor of Ralph Wright who passed recently.
19. Lee Eihausen said that the board needs to reconsider the waiving of the work bond for members over 70.
20. The board will consider whether members should be registered to vote.
21. Clark Calve said that the special lighting for the Juniors at 33 feet would cost about \$2,800.
22. Clark Calve moved to give the four-man crew who installed and set up the new video system one years free membership. The motion passed unanimously.
23. Tom Rodriguez said that the club is out of patches. Lee Eihausen will see to ordering 500.
24. The board needs to consider the policy of a member with guests. The policy now states that the member can't shoot, only the guests can.
25. The board attended a demonstration of the new video system.
26. The meeting was adjourned.
