CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

December 11, 2009

1. The meeting was called to order by Lee Ormiston at 7:07 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.
2. There were no comments concerning the minutes to the recent meetings.
3. There were no comments addressed to the board from the members present.
4. The secretary requested a special board meeting to discuss the bylaws requirement that a member must have been a member of the club for three years to qualify to run for the board. A motion to convene a special board meeting passed. A discussion followed resulting in the determination that following the requirements of the bylaws outweighed the contributions of a member. A motion to adjourn the special board meeting passed.
5. The membership coordinator reported 302 renewals of a total membership of approximately 630.
6. Clark Calve reported that he was holding eight access cards pending the new member taking the safety class.
7. Mike Hopkins reported that the HVAC and roof replacement effort is moving forward with a tentative completion date of February 12.

8. Don Eyser said that the next work party would be on December 12. Don said that all doors must be open and all exhaust fans must be working when the power washer is used. Don said that there were many workers at the last work party.
9. Denise Henry said that the newsletter is on schedule and that December 27 left off the calendar in the last newsletter.
10. Gary Trisdale reported that the Juniors are doing well and that one Junior, Samantha Trisdale, set a new national record. There were 267 shooters at major match at the Olympic Training Center.
11. Curt Lackey reported that his daughter won the Colorado Junior's shotgun match.
12. Lee Eihausen reported that all bills have been paid.
13. Bill Bierbach said that there are five applicants to be inducted into the club and that two members have qualified for use of the rifle tube. The next tube qualification class will be early on December 18.
14. Warren Johnston said that he has re-keyed the door locks for limited access during the HVAC construction period.
15. Lee Ormiston said that the 2008 tax form and the club's business plan are available for review.
16. Tom Rodriguez read the list of nominees for the 2010 Board of Directors. Lee Ormiston asked whether there were any further nominations from the floor; there were none. A motion was made to close the nominations which passed. Each nominee talked of what they do for the club and why they wished to be on the board. The vote for the 2010 Board of Directors was taken.
17. Prospective new member's applications were read to the members present. Each applicant acknowledged his/her presence. The applicants are: James Deeth, Jeremy Grutt, William Jennings, Brian Lynch, Howard Pollack, and Irene Hanson-Enos. The applicants were accepted into the club by unanimous vote.
18. The secretary admonished the new members to read the Green Book, know the rules and policies and return a signed letter of Affirmation. To disobey any rule results in a meeting with the Board of Directors to discuss the infraction and to decide on what action to take.
19. The meeting was recessed pending the results of the election of the 2010 Board of Directors. The election results are as follows: Bill Bierbach, Clark Calve, Lee Eihausen, Don Eyser, Bob Fulcomer, Denise Henry, Mike Hopkins, Warren Johnston, Lee Ormiston, Nevin Seeger, Don Shearer, Chuck Towne, and Gary Trisdale.

21. The general meeting was adjourned at 8:17 PM.

December 18, 2009

1. The meeting was called to order by Lee Ormiston at 7:06 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. There were two comments addressed to the Board from members present concerning the election of the 2010 Board of Directors.
3. The Secretary read a note from Denis Fluman who thanked the Board for being named a life member of the club.
4. The Secretary read an e-mail from Patrick Barnett, the director of the Pistol Winter League, alerting the participants to the possibility that some league nights may have to be postponed due to the HVAC and roofing work.
5. Chuck Towne reported that approximately 350 of the total membership of 630 have renewed their membership. The dead line for renewal is December 31 after which members will be charged a late fee of \$50.
6. Clark Calve said that he is holding twelve membership cards pending the members taking the safety course.
7. Mike Hopkins reported that the electrical exhaust fans have been received and that work on them being installed may be as soon as Monday. Mike said that the Colorado Senate is revising the CSU gun ban policy.
8. Denise Henry said that the newsletter is on schedule.
9. Bill Bierbach reported two members have qualified for use of the rifle tube.
10. Ron Rosenberg said that he fixed the problem that Don Shearer had in accessing the club's web site.
11. Gary Trisdale reported that the Junior's are doing well and that there a few new members. Gary is trying to find some used rifles but may have to resort to buying new. The Small Bore Winter League fees have been collected from participants and that he expects that the range rent will take all but \$100.

12. Warren Johnston said that the next work party would be on 16 January.
13. Don Eyser reported that the last work party had eight attending and that the rifle tube shooting room was painted by Bob Stone.
14. Lee Eihausen reported that all renewal monies have been deposited except for the money taken in tonight.
15. Bob Fleming addressed the board concerning the Apple Seed/Revolutionary War Veterans Association who would like to train students in firearms. Bob anticipates starting off slow by using only one side of the facility for one whole weekend. The Association is insured, participants will sign waiver and, with approval, will start in February or March.
16. Mike Hopkins made a motion that the Board of Directors of the Cherry Creek Gun Club approved all actions of the Board for the year 2009 as being in the best interest of the Club. The board attested to this assertion by unanimous vote.
17. Don Shearer said that the Club's business plan needs to be updated for 2010 and that he will contact the members of the board for input.
18. Chuck Towne requested that the board convene an executive session which was made into a motion and passed unanimously.
19. The meeting was reconvened and then adjourned at 8:53 PM.
