## Reminders

1. Firing center fire rifles, such as 9mm Luger rounds, is not permitted on the pistol ranges. Center fire rifles are to be fired in the rifle tube.
2. When using the rifle tube it is only necessary to sign the log book when either you are bringing a guest into the tube or you are logging the location of damage to the tube.
3. Memberships are for an individual. If you bring a non-member to the club, no matter what her/his relationship is to you, a guest fee must be paid and a waiver must be signed by both you and your guest.

## Changes to the CCGC Rules in the Members Book Since Publication in July 2009

1. No multiple projectile, shot loads, or shot shells are to be fired in any firearm at the Cherry Creek Gun Club, Inc. facility.
2. Guest fee changed to \$5.00 per guest.
3. Membership re-instatement fee changed to one-half of the membership fee due. For example, if membership renewal fee is \$150 dollars and membership is not renewed by December 31, then the total of the membership renewal fee and the membership re-instatement fee paid in January or later is  $\$150 + \$75 = \$225$ .

## CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

June 11, 2010

1. The meeting was called to order by Lee Ormiston at 7:01 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.
2. There were no corrections to the last meeting's minutes.
3. There were no comments from the members present.
4. The Secretary has received an e-mail from a member who requests Inactive status. This item will be resolved at the next Board meeting. The Secretary wrote a letter to a member who broke several rules. This member has been requested to appear before the Board to explain his actions.
5. Chuck Towne reported that the membership count is 571 and that he has sent letters or e-mails to 13 members whose NRA membership has expired. Six of those members have responded with their new expiration date. From the last batch of letters or e-mails sent in May, there are three who have not responded and their access to the facility has been turned off.
6. Don Shearer reported that the chronograph in lane 1 of the rifle tube is not working well. He will try to fix the problem.
7. Nevin Seeger said that it appears that volunteers who work at the facility are covered by the Club's insurance. He is looking into the Club's 501 c 3 status.
8. Denise Henry reported that the newsletter is on schedule.
9. Bill Bierbach reported that he has qualified a couple of members for use of the rifle tube. Bill has been looking at the minutes of the Club meetings and has written a paper on Board decisions since the Membership Booklet (green book) was last updated. The Board members have been e-mailed a copy of this paper. The next rifle tube qualification will be on the 18<sup>th</sup>.
10. Warren Johnston said that the next work party would be on the 19<sup>th</sup>. Don Eyser said that the work would be to paint the outside ends of the building, weather permitting.
11. Gary Trisdale is with the Juniors at a small bore rifle match.
12. Lee Eihausen said that he contacted the phone company and changed the service for a savings of approximately \$31 per month.
13. Prospective new member's applications were read to the members present. Each applicant acknowledged his/her presence. The applicants are: Philip Anderson, Laurence Mapp, Steve Riley and Zachary Roth (Collegiate). Two members spoke of the safety habits of two of the applicants. The applicants were accepted into the club by unanimous vote. The secretary admonished the new members to read the membership (green) booklet and know the rules and to read the newsletter as it is the only source of transmitting club business. The president said that the new member orientation class will be viewed as well as spoken. The rifle tube orientation class is on the third Friday of the month and there is a sign up sheet in the rifle tube door. Work parties are on the third Saturday of the month.

14. Don Shearer said that he is the emergency contact for the Club relative to membership safety issues. A volunteer who lives close to the facility is needed for facility emergencies. Don Eyser volunteered.
15. Bill Bierbach asked for clarification of the use of the sign up logs for the pistol range and for the rifle tube. The issue will be discussed at the next Board meeting.
16. Bill Bierbach said that the noise from the pistol range is louder than before the HVAC update. This issue will be discussed at the next Board meeting.
17. Mike Hopkins asked the Board to check the pistol range between lanes 8 and 9. Someone has shot into the upper most plates and left some major dents and holes. A review of the video recordings will attempt to identify the perpetrator.
18. The general meeting was adjourned at 7:39 PM.

## **CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING**

June 25, 2010

Attendees: Towne, Eihausen, Bierbach, Johnston, Hopkins, Ormiston, Shearer, Eyser, Seeger, and Lackey. Henry and Trisdale were excused.

1. The meeting was called to order by Lee Ormiston at 7:02 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. There were no comments from the members present.
3. There was no correspondence received by the Secretary.
4. The Secretary reported that there are 575 current members. The mailing on May 18 to those members who were not current NRA members has resulted in three members who have not responded and who have had their access card turned off. Of the June 7 mailing, six have not responded and their access cards will be turned off on July 5, 2010 unless they respond.
5. Don Shearer has updated the Business Plan and has asked that certain Board members review it. Hopkins, Seeger and Towne will do the reviewing. Don said that he will be absent at the next meeting.

6. Mike Hopkins had no report on the process of properly cleaning the range.
7. Don Eyser reported that the next work party would paint the ends of the building and change out some faulty lighting.
8. Nevin Seeger said that he should be ready with his report on the Club's insurance next meeting.
9. Bill Bierbach reported that one range light had fallen and that it has been replaced. Bill said that four members were qualified for rifle tube use. There are five applications received for processing at the next General Meeting.
10. Don Eyser reported that he is in process of establishing a master set of keys after which some of the facilities locks would be changed.
11. Lee Eihausen, Treasurer, said that all is quiet.
12. Warren Johnston said he is working on the master set of facility keys and asked whether there are other keys to be included.
13. Bill Bierbach asked for clarification of signing in on the log for the rifle tube. The Board concluded that signing in is necessary when a member has a guest or when damage is discovered and needs reporting.
14. There had been a question from a member that the chronograph was not working correctly. Don Shearer said that the sensing screen bulbs must be white, not clear and that he feels that the member has a faulty chronograph recorder.
15. Bill Bierbach asked about noise attenuation since the update of the HVAC system. After a discussion to include possible recommendations, a committee of Shearer and Hopkins will address the issue.
16. The Secretary said that a member has requested inactive status due to a move. By unanimous vote the Board approved inactive status for Kevin Mcguire.
17. The Secretary reported that a member has requested work bond relief since he is over 70 years of age. By unanimous vote the Board granted the request of Jack Mallicoat and he will be refunded his \$50.
18. Lee Ormiston reported that the range had experienced an electrical outage. A suggestion was to obtain an uninterrupted power supply to allow time to secure sensitive systems. The power

outage was due to a blown 150 amp fuse on one leg of the power input. Mike Hopkins will investigate the power supply suggestion.

19. Lee Ormiston said that there was a question by a member whether he could shoot a pistol cartridge in a rifle in the pistol range. The answer was no! Only 22 long rifle cartridges may be fired in rifles on the pistol range.

20. The meeting was adjourned at 7:46 PM.
