While one guest was shooting without supervision by the member, the member and the other guest repeatedly faced the meeting room, presented pistols from holsters, and they both made half-circle turns and engaged a down range target. The turning guest covered the other guest each time he turned around. The member covered both guests each time he turned around. Luckily, no one is DEAD or INJURED.

Another member received a letter of censure for a personal action.

NO ONE is authorized to work from a holster at the Cherry Creek Gun Club, Inc. facility! The facility is a concrete box. A negligent discharge will result in either bullet splatter or a ricochet. In either situation bullet fragments will go in unintended directions. If one of these fragments severs a major artery, that person will bleed out in a few minutes. Is this something you want to do to yourself or your friend? Think about the safety of yourself and your friends!!

CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

February 12, 2010

1. The meeting was called to order by Lee Ormiston at 7:04 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.
2. There were no corrections to the last meeting minutes.
3. Jeff Kwon asked if the club had WiFi access...the club does not. Jeff asked whether ads may be placed in the newsletter...they may. Jeff asked that the club's financial position be posted in the newsletter...not normally but it is in the business plan which is on the club's web site. A member asked: does the outside video cameras have the capability to pick up license plate numbers...no they can't.
4. Chuck Towne reported that the renewal notices were first sent out in October when there were 613 members. Since that time, the club has gained 26 new members. There are 106 members who have not renewed their membership leaving 533 active members. Since the original renewal mailing, there have been 89 renewals resent.
5. Clark Calve reported that he is holding eight membership cards pending the members taking the safety course. Clark said that the pop machine is full and the phone answering service is empty.
6. Mike Hopkins thanked Clark Calve for his monitoring of the facility renovation. The work is not complete and will take some time for completion. The HVAC air flow has been balanced but the diffusion of the air is still a problem. The gas flow to the different services needs to be increased which may require a different regulator. A question concerning the sound of firearms being fired

emanating from the facility needs to be addressed. It is anticipated that there will be no need for additional range closures.

7. Warren Johnston reported that carrier 14 needs a new motor or at least new drive gears.
8. Don Eyser reported a good turnout at the last work party and that the range will be receiving periodic power washes. Don needs volunteers for janitors.
9. Denise Henry reported that the newsletter is on schedule.
10. Kurt Lackey asked for the warranty plan on the HVAC...it is good for five years.
11. Lee Eihausen said that he is continuing with picking up the mail and processing it.
12. Bill Bierbach reported that he and Jeff Kwon have qualified five members for use of the rifle tube.
13. Gary Trisdale said that three girls and two boys from the Juniors have qualified for the Junior Olympics.
14. Prospective new member's applications were read to the members present. Each applicant acknowledged his/her presence. The applicants are: Paul Clark Sr., Adam Pollack (Jr.), Matt Pollack (Jr.), and Robert Bachtel. The applicants were accepted into the club by unanimous vote.
15. Bill Bierbach asked the board members present for their support in continuing research on setting up a seminar on predator calling. The board gave its approval.
16. The general meeting was adjourned at 7:45 PM.

February 26, 2010

Attendees: Towne, Calve, Eihausen, Bierbach, Hopkins, Trisdale, Shearer, Henry, Ormiston, Seeger, and Johnston. Eyser was excused.

1. The meeting was called to order by Lee Ormiston at 7:04 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. There was one comment from the members present. The member thanked Mike Pease and Lee Eihausen for there help in returning a lost wedding ring to the members wife.
3. The Secretary read an e-mail from a collegiate member who wanted his late fee reduced. A motion to not reduce the late fee passed.
4. The secretary read an e-mail from an Associate member who wished to become a regular member due to divorcing her husband who is a

regular member. The Board's decision was that she would have to apply as a new member.

5. The secretary read an e-mail by a member who complained of a member smoking in the facility. The club policy is that there is no smoking allowed in the facility.
6. The Board discussed a member who was observed firing from a holster. Some of the holster work was, with his back to the target, drawing then turning and firing. 13. Clark Calve submitted his resignation from the Board effective immediately due to personal reasons.
