GUEST FEES:

Members are reminded to pay the guest fee and complete the waiver form when entering the facility.

If the waiver form is not completed and the guest fee is not paid, the guest is a trespasser and the member is stealing from the other club members.

SAFETY FIRST:

When someone needs to go forward of the firing line on the pistol range, it is important that everyone follow basic safety rules.

- 1) All guns should be unloaded, and magazines removed/cylinders opened.
- 2) No one should handle any gun on the line while anyone is forward of the firing line.
- 3) In addition, Open Chamber Indicators (OCIs) are highly recommended. This is a device that is inserted into the chamber to show that there is not a round in the chamber. These are required at most competitions in this country. Soon, we will begin supplying simple OCIs and recommend their use. This is an added precaution against accidental discharge of a gun that someone "thought" was unloaded.

NOTE: The rules for the tube are unchanged. Rifles must be unloaded and racked before anyone goes forward of the door. OCIs are also recommended for the racked rifles.

Reminders

1. Firing center fire rifles, such as 9mm Luger rounds, is not permitted on the pistol ranges. Center fire rifles are to be fired in the rifle tube.

2. When using the rifle tube it is only necessary to sign the log book when either you bring a guest into the tube or you are logging the location of damage to the tube.

3. Memberships are for an individual. If you bring a non-member to the club, no matter what her/his relationship is to you, a guest fee must be paid and a waiver must be signed by both you and your guest.

Changes to the CCGC Rules in the Members Book since Publication in July 2009

1. No multiple projectile, shot loads, or shot shells are to be fired in any firearm at the Cherry Creek Gun Club, Inc. facility.

2. Guest fee changed to \$5.00 per guest.

3. Membership re-instatement fee changed to one-half of the membership fee due. For example, if membership renewal fee is \$150 dollars and membership is not renewed by December 31, then the total of the membership renewal fee and the membership re-instatement fee paid in January or later is $\$150 + \$75 = \$225$.

4. Safety in the tube: All shots should be located one at a time. The gun must be used as a single shot. (a) Rim fire rifles may have a MAXIMUM of 5 rounds loaded at any one time.

CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

October 8, 2010

1. The meeting was called to order by Lee Ormiston at 7:01 PM followed by the pledge to the flag. Seeger, Shearer and Johnston were excused from the meeting.
2. There were no corrections to the last meeting's minutes.
3. There were no comments from the members present.

4. The Secretary read a letter of resignation from the Board of Directors from Bill Bierbach effective December 31, 2010.
5. Chuck Towne reported receiving 126, 2011 renewal notices back from members.
6. Mike Hopkins reported that new diffusers have been installed in the pistol range and that the system needs to be balanced.
7. Denise Henry reported that the newsletter is on schedule.
8. Don Eyser said that he received a report that the door lock was not working correctly and that he checked it out and found it OK. The next work party will be on October 16 and the work will be painting the back stop and power washing the west range.
9. Gary Trisdale reported that the Juniors are very busy and that he had a full line last night at practice even though not all of the Juniors were there.
10. Lee Eihausen said that money is tight.
11. Bill Bierbach reported that there are six Regular and two Junior applicants for membership to be inducted tonight. Bill has qualified four members for use of the rifle tube and explained the process of getting qualified for use of the rifle tube.
12. Prospective new member's applications were read to the members present. Each applicant acknowledged his/her presence. The applicants are: Matthew Anderson (Coll.), Paul Burns, Marlin Richardson (Coll.), Stuart Ritter, Stephan Sendelbach, Cody Clayton (Jr.), and Kyle Clayton (Jr.). The applicants were accepted into the club by unanimous vote. The secretary admonished the new members to read the membership (green) booklet and know the rules and to read the newsletter as it is the only source of transmitting club business. The president said that the new member orientation class will follow the meeting.
13. The general meeting was adjourned at 7:29 PM.

CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

October 29, 2010

Attendees: Towne, Bierbach, Eihausen, Ormiston, Henry, Shearer, Eyser, Seeger, Trisdale, Johnston, and Lackey.

1. The meeting was called to order by Lee Ormiston at 7:01 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. There were no comments from the members present.
3. The Secretary read a letter by a member who feels strongly that he had paid the guest fee and had the waiver forms filled out by his

two guests. After a discussion, it was concluded that it is possible to miss the act of paying the guest fee and filling out the waiver form. The discussion revealed that not all members who bring in guests take care of the fees and waiver in the same manner. Some do it immediately, some later and some not at all. For those who do it later, the reviewer has already concluded that the fees and waiver were not going to be done and bypasses the remainder of that member's activities. The recommendation is that members should pay the guest fee and fill out the waiver form immediately on entering the facility.

4. Don Shearer reported that the Club is a member in good standing of the NRA
5. Chuck Towne reported that only 178 members have renewed their membership for 2011 at this time.
6. Denise Henry said that the newsletter is on schedule.
7. Lee Eihausen said that the Club financial activities are as usual.
8. Don Eyser reported that the last work party was well attended and that a lot of work was accomplished.
9. Gary Trisdale reported that there some new Junior members and the Juniors are doing well.
10. Bill Bierbach reported that he and Jeff Kwon qualified seven members for use of the tube. There will be six or seven applications to process at the next General Meeting.
11. The Board had a lengthy discussion concerning the Club's current CPA and the Clubs request for pricing for 2011. The discussion concluded that a letter be written, reviewed and be sent with the intent to resolve the issue.
12. Lee Ormiston said that the Pistol Winter League has requested that the League start and end one week later. A motion to accept the request passed. The League will start on October 25 and end March 21.
13. Lee Ormiston said that the Pistol 2700 match dates for November and December conflict with the work parties for those two months. The work parties will be moved to November 13 and December 11.
14. Carlton Steubing sent a letter requesting Emeritus status as he has been with the Club for over fifteen years and is now 65 years of age. A motion to grant his request was approved unanimously.

15. The Board discussed reviewing the video system. The proper procedure for paying the guest fees and signing the Waiver form will be placed in the newsletter.
16. The Board discussed the practice of leaving a safe firearm pointing down range and walking down range in front of the firearm. In the tube, the rule will stand that all rifles be made safe and be placed in the rifle rack prior to going down range. The Juniors will make up chamber flag safety indicators and have them available for the Pistol Winter League, for the Pistol 2700 matches and for the Juniors.
17. Chuck Towne moved that a lap top computer be purchased and be dedicated for the formation of the Club's newsletter. A motion was made and passed with a limit of \$1,000 for the purchase.
18. Brent Cain asked that Willy Schroth be given access to the vault for setting up the range for the Pistol Winter League on Monday nights.
19. The meeting was adjourned at 9:06 PM.
