NRA Memberships:

Reminders

1. Firing center fire rifles, such as 9mm Luger rounds, is not permitted on the pistol ranges. Center fire rifles are to be fired in the rifle tube.
2. When using the rifle tube it is only necessary to sign the log book when either you bring a guest into the tube or you are logging the location of damage to the tube.
3. Memberships are for an individual. If you bring a non-member to the club, no matter what her/his relationship is to you, a guest fee must be paid and a waiver must be signed by both you and your guest.

Changes to the CCGC Rules in the Members Book since Publication in July 2009

1. No multiple projectile, shot loads, or shot shells are to be fired in any firearm at the Cherry Creek Gun Club, Inc. facility.
2. Guest fee changed to \$5.00 per guest.
3. Membership re-instatement fee changed to one-half of the membership fee due. For example, if membership renewal fee is \$150 dollars and membership is not renewed by December 31, then the total of the membership renewal fee and the membership re-instatement fee paid in January or later is $\$150 + \$75 = \$225$.

CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

August 13, 2010

1. The meeting was called to order by Lee Ormiston at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag. Seeger was excused from the meeting.
2. There were no comments from the members present.
3. There were no corrections to the last meeting's minutes.

4. Chuck Towne reported that there are 582 current members, eight of whom are suspended as they have not renewed their NRA membership.
5. Don Shearer said that the chronograph screens are now working although he is watching the lane three screens for reliability.
6. Don Eyser reported that the next work party would be on August 21 and that the HVAC drain would be changed from draining inside to draining outside the building. Don said that the work party schedule in the last newsletter needs to be checked.
7. Denise Henry reported that the newsletter is on schedule.
8. Gary Trisdale reported that State Games have started and that the Juniors who attended did well.
9. Lee Eihausen said that he had to transfer some money from the savings account to the checking account.
10. Mike Hopkins said that he is still trying to find the origin of where water is leaking from the roof.
11. Bill Bierbach reported that updates to the membership booklet (Green Book) have been included with the applicants for membership packet and that the green book must be read. Bill qualified two members for tube use and explained the process for getting qualified for use of the tube.
12. Don Eyser said that he authorized the mowing of the weeds around the building.
13. Prospective new member's applications were read to the members present. Each applicant acknowledged his/her presence. The applicants are: Danny Naab, Kurt Gross, Donald Baumgardner, Brenton Cain, Glenn Feit, Penelope Feit (Assoc.) and Christina Francone. The applicants were accepted into the club by unanimous vote. The secretary admonished the new members to read the membership (green) booklet and know the rules and to read the newsletter as it is the only source of transmitting club business. The president said that the new member orientation class will be viewed as well as spoken.
14. The general meeting was adjourned at 7:28 PM.

CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

August 27, 2010

Attendees: Towne, Bierbach, Hopkins, Eihausen, Johnston, Ormiston, Shearer, Henry, Trisdale, Eyser, and Seeger.

1. The meeting was called to order by Lee Ormiston at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. There were no comments from the members present.

3. The Secretary said that correspondence received included a notice that the Club was a member of USA Shooting and a letter from a member with an article which discussed the recent Disclosure Bill passed by the House but not by the Senate. Because it was defeated, no discussion was deemed necessary.
4. The Secretary reported on a committee meeting that interviewed two members who are possible CPAs for the Club.
5. Don Shearer reported that someone has removed an orange filter from one of the chronograph screens in the tube.
6. Mike Hopkins said that the range would be closed next Tuesday for work on the range sumps. There have been many complaints concerning shooting pistol rounds in rifles in the pistol range. The complainers said that they had not been aware of the rules change. Mike made a review of the various editions of the Membership booklet that defined the rules concerning this issue. Each edition states that only rifles employing 22 rim fire cartridges are allowed in the pistol range (or words to that effect). The editions of the Membership booklet which state this rule were published in: July 1998, page 16, item 2; 2004, page 12, item 1; September 2008, page 17, item 1; July 2009, page 17, item 1.
7. Denise Henry said that the newsletter is on schedule.
8. Warren Johnston said that the next work party would be on 18 September.
9. A member suggested that new members be given a twenty question quiz to assure that they have read the Membership booklet.
10. Gary Trisdale said that two Juniors who have enrolled in military academies have passed their basic training. One adult and two Juniors have attended a coaches class.
11. Bill Bierbach reported that one member has qualified for tube use and that there are five or six new applications for membership.
12. Don Shearer said that the chronograph screens on the right lanes are OK and that he will have to buy new screens for the left side.
13. Lee Eihausen said that members who enter the range through the west door do not necessarily have their guests pay the guest fee nor sign the Waiver form. Many suggestions were made to include changing the lock on the west door, turn off the access card reader to the west door, put in another box with Waiver forms, and make an example of a member who brings in guests without following

the proper policy(ies). A committee of John Cast, Bill Bierbach, Gary Trisdale and Don Shearer was formed to consider the issue.

14. Chuck Towne said that the renewal notices for 2011 will go out the week following the September general meeting. There are 589 current members. Since May, four members have had their access suspended because they are not current NRA members.
15. Gary Trisdale reminded the Board that a nominating committee needs to be formed by the October General meeting. Don Eyser will serve from the Board.
16. The Secretary read a notice which will be part of the renewal notice package reminding the membership of the Clubs responsibilities to the membership and the responsibilities of the membership to the Club. It was noted that a guest who does not pay the guest fee nor sign the Waiver form may be considered trespassers and would have no rights.
17. Warren Johnston said that he has a member looking into the door access system and the lighting system.
20. The meeting was adjourned at 7:51 PM.
