## CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

June 10, 2011

1. Meeting was called to order by Tom Deherrera at 6:58 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag. Trisdale not at meeting. 11 guests.
2. Don Eyser reported that the work party will be on June 18 for removal of lead.
3. Alan Montoya reported that no one qualified for the rifle. Stated that there is a manila envelope with what to bring and not bring for qualification.
4. Treasurer reported monthly bills paid.
5. Denise Henry reported that the newsletter is on schedule.
6. Carlton Steubing wants opinions and feedback from members that read the newsletter one of them being if anyone has guest speaker ideas. President interjected that it may be necessary for a raise in dues next year.
7. Secretary reported that the video digital recording surveillance system had been replaced at a cost of \$1,275.00 on 6/8/11. There was a question from the general membership on warranty on the old system and how the decision was made to replace the system. It was explained that the system warranty had expired and the original contractor that installed the first system was called to fix or replace it. It was determined that the system would be cheaper to replace than fix. A new system was authorized as we needed to have a video system functioning for insurance purposes. There is a 3 year warranty on the new system.
8. New member applications were read and each applicant spoke about themselves and their firearms experience. The applicants are Larry Aughenbaugh, Tom McGee, Thuha Kerber, Daniel Kerber, Joseph D'Ambrosia, Michael Ward, Steve Stone, Russell Chapman, Jack Fatjo, Heath Dorris, Charles Parkhurst, Taylor Parkhurst, Mark Brewster, Skip Francoeur, and Stephen Francoeur. The applicants were accepted in to the club by unanimous vote.
9. New Business
  - a) Steubing reminded the membership that juniors (under 19) must be under direct adult supervision on the range. If the adult leaves the range for any reason the junior is to also leave the range.
  - b) Steubing stated that nonmembers of the club that shoot competitively do not pay guest fees therefore he feels that they are being subsidized by the club. He feels that anyone who is not a member of the club should pay the \$5 guest fee no

matter if they are in a competition (bowling pin, Monday night bullseye, 2700 bullseye, winter small-bore league, juniors).

Secretary stated that the club has a rental agreement with the shooting groups for the space of \$7/Hr per range and that we cannot arbitrarily demand that they charge an extra \$5 for nonclub members. If we want to increase the hourly charge for the groups that is a different matter.

Orischak would like the prod of a guest fee to increase membership. There was a comment that a high percentage of the shooters for the groups are members of the club and we should check out other clubs prices that they charge for competitions.

It was decided to see what the actual percentage of people are shooting in the competitions are not members of the club.

- c) Eyser asked for clarification if there will be payment for the workbonds for lead removal on June 18th. There will be workbond payment for the lead removal.

10. General meeting was adjourned.

## CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

June 24, 2011

Attendees: Bailey, Deherrera, Eihausen, Eyser, Henry, Johnston, Kwon, Montoya, Orischak, Steubing, and Trisdale. Not present Seeger. 7 guests.

1. Meeting was called to order by Tom Deherrera at 6:59 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. Meeting was opened to members with any comments.
  - a) Bill Bierbach requested to be “updated on the status of the roof project and HVAC system and where we are at. Wants to know whether or not decisions have been made and agreements have been finalized. And whether or not checks have been written and bills have been paid. .... are these projects still in limbo...any open items.”

Secretary responded that at this time the board has not yet decided to give this information because of legal issues. Once the board and lawyer feel that there will be no issues the detailed information will be provided to all the general membership.

- b) Steve Locatelli Presented a proposed schedule for 2700 bullseye match for 2011-12 year. East range to be reserved from 06:00 to 18:00 on match days. Range rent of \$84.00 per match. Proposed schedule:

Sept 24, 2011	Jan 28, 2012
Oct 29, 2011	Feb 25, 2012
Nov 19, 2011	March 24, 2012
Dec 17, 2011	April 28, 2012

He gave a historical background and requested that the board approve the rent and dates for competition.

There was discussion on increase of rental rate, what members or nonmembers shoot at the match. How these costs would affect the matches. Steve stated that the 2700 matches are presently breaking even. Charter of the gun club is to promote shooting.

Proposal was made and passed that the requested schedule for 2700 bullseye monthly matches and rent of \$84 per match for rental fees be agreed to and that if the board increases the rental fee that the matches be given 2 month notice before the increase in cost or dues can be applied to the matches.

3. Eysler stated that the next work Party is June 25<sup>th</sup> as it was postponed for lead removal. Stated that he may know who took the lead out of the west range and that he is in process of looking into it.
4. Denise Henry reported that the newsletter is on schedule.
5. Gary Trisdale reported that the juniors are busy and that 3-4 of them will be going to Ft Benning to shoot a match next week.
6. Lee Eihausen stated that all bills had been paid.
7. Alan Montoya reported that 4 members qualified for the tube this week. And that we are down to 35 green books (member's book bylaws policies). He thinks that we will need a new run of copies in 2 months they will cost \$1.60 a piece.

Secretary put forth information requested about honorary membership and what the insurance company policy was in relation to NRA membership and background checks. The insurance company policy is that all members must have current NRA memberships and that the background checks are purely dependent on the boards wishes.
8. Deherrera thanked Clark Calve for painting gas line pipe that was left unpainted at the club and Jim Schwartz for bring down a refrigerator for the club.
9. Secretary Communications
  - a) Member requested that they would like to put an ad in the newsletter regarding subletting office space.

There was discussion as to what had been done in the past. Ad's had been sold for \$5/business card. They should be shooting related ads. This is a potential money maker. After discussion it was voted that no business ads will be allowed in the newsletter.
  - b) What would the board like to do with the old digital recorder for the camera system?

There was question if there was any value. It decided that the disk be destroyed. Bailey will dispose of the recorder.
  - c) Member asked how to get a login to the club webpage.

This prompts the questions of:

Do we need to have a login to the webpage?

If we do continue with login accounts do we authorize the IT manager to receive the member data base to enter new accounts?

Discussion went from there is no need for the member login as there is nothing sensitive on the webpage and it is all generic. The only potential sensitive information is the newsletter and any financial information.

Motion was made to keep the member login and just give the IT personnel only member name and card numbers. Motion failed.

Motion was made “to remove password accounts from the webpage make it in to a generic form and remove the newsletter from the webpage.” Motion passed.

## 10. Unfinished Business

Jack Orischak put in a motion to change the bylaws of the club at the General meeting on May 13, 2011. At the May board meeting a subcommittee was formed to work on the wording. Below is the submitted change to the bylaws presented by the subcommittee.

### Article III, Section 3, paragraph C and D:

Current wording:

Voting to the Board of Directors shall be by secret ballot. Thirteen (13) members receiving the majority of the votes cast and who are otherwise eligible to hold office as a director shall be declared elected. Their term of office shall commence on January 1 following their election.

Members elected to the Board of Directors shall serve for one (1) year or until their successors have been elected or appointed. Any Board member who resigns or who is absent from three (3) regular meetings of the Board of Directors in a given calendar year without good and sufficient reason in the judgment of the Board may be regarded as having terminated his/her Board membership and shall be so notified.

Proposed wording:

Voting to the Board of Directors shall be by secret ballot. Thirteen (13) members receiving the majority of the votes cast and who are otherwise eligible to hold office as a director shall be declared elected. ~~Their term of office shall commence on January 1 following their election.~~ ***Their term of office shall commence immediately following their election. Any and all club business from the time of the election through 31 December of that same year shall be acted on by both the current and newly elected members.***

Members elected to the Board of Directors shall serve for one (1) year ***(through December 31 of the year following their election)*** or until their successors have been elected or appointed. Any Board member who resigns or who is absent from three (3) regular meetings of the Board of Directors in a given calendar year without good and sufficient reason in the judgment of the Board may be regarded as having terminated his/her Board membership and shall be so notified.

Article II, Section 1, paragraph D, Life Membership

Current wording:

Life membership maybe awarded to any Club member in recognition of outstanding service to the Club, either present or in the past, of for participation in Club activities. A Life member shall have all of the rights and privileges of an individual member but shall be assessed no fees or dues.

Proposed wording:

Life membership maybe awarded to any Club member in recognition of outstanding service to the Club, either present or in the past, of for participation in Club activities. A Life member shall have all of the rights and privileges of an individual member but shall be assessed no fees or dues. ***The granting of Life Membership shall require approval at 2 separate Board of Directors meetings.***

The committee asked that all board members be forward this information. Proposal was tabled until 10 day time period passes and then a discussion and vote will be taken.

11. New business:

Trisdale stated that the USA shooting membership is coming up so he will turn it in. CMP membership came up for renewal in January or February which he paid and he will turn that in to the treasurer.

Orischak requested that because of the potential increase in membership dues, due to rising costs that there be appointed a 2 or 3 man committee to take a look at the projected budget for the coming year to analyze cost increase and make a recommendations to the board.

President stated that the three officers with the accountant will work to find that information.

12. Meeting adjourned
