## **CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB GENERAL MEETING MINUTES**

**May 11, 2012**

The general membership meeting for the month of May, 2012 was held as scheduled on May 11, 2012 at the club house.

Note: Our club secretary was excused for personal reasons from this general membership meeting. Minutes were kept by Mr. Jim Enos a board member to be relayed to Mr. Lima to be included in the next Firing Line newsletter.

President Mr. Jim Bailey called the meeting to order at 1900 followed by the pledge of allegiance

### **OLD BUSINESS / BOARD MEMBER REPORTS:**

1. Mr. Clark Clave was called upon and reported that the hood installation on the clubs HVAC was complete and a final inspection by the city was scheduled for May 14, 2012.

2. Mr. Allan Montoya reported that there were no qualifications performed in the tube last month and if anyone was interested in signing up to please do so for the next scheduled qualification.
3. Mr. Lee Eihausen reported that the clubs Xcel bill for last month was \$1,500.00 due to the warm weather.
4. Mr. Gary Trisdale reported that some of the juniors (two) will be traveling with him to Fort Benning, Georgia for a shoot the first of June. We wish them well.
5. Mr. Tom DeHerrera reported also that the HVAC hoods had been installed and the cost for the entire job was \$3,000.00. The club thanks the members that worked on the project and a special thanks to the non-members (friends of Tom's) that assisted in the project. THANKS!
6. Mr. Jack Orischak reported that the clubs project of planting trees was half done. Mr. Orischak also requested a special meeting of the board members present at the conclusion of the general membership to discuss upgrading the present water system to include the watering of the new trees. This was agreed to by club president Mr. Jim Bailey.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

1. Question regarding the future installation of AC being extended into the rifle tube was discussed, Mr. Clark Calve reported to the membership that this was being looked at. It was discussed that a concern regarding this is that it might cause the club issues in regard to noise being carried from the rifle tube. More to follow on this subject upon further study.
2. Jim Bailey read the applications for membership. The applicants talked of their interest in the club, and their experience with firearms and the sport of hunting. There were 13 new member applicants: Alexandre Oricheve, Igor Makarov, Christopher Love, Damion McLaughlin, Coleman Powell, Douglas Dendy, Joseph Maestas, Michael Thomas, Thomas Reed, Glen Schoales, Stephen Lundine, Mike Giovanni, and Edward Zeldin.

All potential members told a little about themselves and were excused to the pistol range area. A vote was taken by the attending membership and all were accepted to the club. Our new members were asked to rejoin the general meeting and welcomed to the club. It was explained to them that Mr. Clark Calve would be holding a pistol range orientation right after the general membership meeting.

3. Denise Henry reported that the memorial services for her late husband had been set for June 11th @ 1700. Mrs. Henry will get us information as to the name and address for all who would like to attend. More information to follow.

The meeting adjournment was called for by Mrs. Denise Henry, seconded and passed.

4. General membership meeting for the month of May was adjourned at 1935.

#### **SPECIAL BOARD MEMBERSHIP MEETING FOR MAY, 11, 2012:**

The special board membership meeting was called to order by Mr. Jim Bailey, President. This meeting was held directly after the general membership meeting on May 11, 2012.

In attendance were the following board members:

Note: Our club secretary was excused for personal reasons from this special board meeting. Minutes was kept by Mr. Jim Enos a board member to be relayed to Mr. Lima to be included in the next Firing Line newsletter.

1. Mr. Jack Orischak thanked the board members and explained that he was asking the board to approve an expenditure to upgrade and improve the present irrigation system to include the newly planted trees. It was agreed by the board that if the upgrade did not exceed one thousand (1,000.00) dollars the club would go forward with the upgrade. A motion was made, seconded and passed by a vote of seven (7) in favor and one (1) opposed.
2. Mr. Lee Eihausen (treasurer) went over existing finances. It was reported that the club still owes the Juniors seven thousand (7,000.00) dollars. A concern was brought up as to the clubs expenditures and the need to start building our funds for the future. It was agreed by all that this is a valid concern.

### CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB BOD MEETING MINUTES May 25, 2012

The meeting was called to order by President Jim Bailey at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

In attendance: Jim Bailey, Alan Montoya, Lee Eihausen, Clark Calve, Jack Orischak, Jack Priest, Gary Trisdale, Jack Johansen, and Joe Lima

Comments from the floor: One of the members present felt the Club sanctioned events such as the 2700 Matches, Pin Shooting, and Bullseye league should pay more in range rental than the current fee of \$7.00 per hour. It was acknowledged that the fee was very favorable but reminded the member that one of the primary purposes of the Club is to promote the sport of shooting and that these sanctioned events attract non member participants some of whom later become members.

The Board of Directors report:

1. Clark Calve reported that the HVAC has been inspected and approved.
2. Jack Orischak reported that the tree planting is about 50% done and is going very well. The plans for the additional irrigation system is in the planning process. The BBQ is on schedule to be held June 10<sup>th</sup> from 1000 to 1800. Cost will be \$15.00 which will benefit the Club. All members are encouraged to attend and bring family and friends. Please let Jack know if you plan to attend so he has some idea as to how much food to prepare.

3. Lee Eihausen reported on the monthly expenses. The Juniors were paid the final amount of \$6500. That represented the last large amount of the Club's outstanding debt. The Club is solvent and has money in the bank
4. Alan Montoya reported two new tube qualifiers.
5. Gary reported that 3 Juniors will accompany him to Fort Benning GA. for a match.

**New Business:**

1. Mark Moody a Firearms Instructor with the United States Mint Police in Denver, has requested the use of the Club Range for training purposes because their range is currently under construction. They would need the range for four consecutive days and can be flexible on the availability. Only one range would be required leaving the other for members to use while the training is being performed. The Club would be compensated for letting them use the facility and liability wavers would be required. A BOD member would be present during the training. A motion was made to allow them to use the Club; the motion was seconded and passed by a majority of the Board.
2. Steve Locatelli presented to the Board a proposal to hold 2700 Matches from September 2012 to April 2013 at the Club. They are scheduled on Saturday of the last full weekend of each month except for November where the match is held earlier due to holidays. A motion was made to allow Mr. Locatelli to conduct the 2700 matches. It was seconded and passed by a majority of the Board.
3. Brent Cain sent an email to the Secretary asking the Board's permission to conduct a summer Bullseye league starting in June and ending in August. A motion was made to allow the summer league. It was seconded and passed by a majority of the Board.
4. Alan Montoya submitted a revised Application Form reflecting the proposed new membership categories: Regular, Associate, and Junior. Military, Junior Family, and Collegiate would no longer be applicable. A motion to accept the new application form was made, and seconded. A majority of the Board passed the motion to accept the new form. However, a question was raised about the fee for the Junior membership which would have gone up to \$25.00. This would require a change in the Bylaws. It was decided that further review would be necessary.
5. A proposal was made by the Secretary to set the fee date for new members to be the date the membership coordinator could reasonably expect a prospective member would be voted into the Club. If for some reason that date was not met no attempt would be made to reimburse the member for the extended period of time. This would make the accounting process much easier and less complicated. A motion was made to accept the proposal. It was seconded and passed by a majority of the Board.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:15 PM
