## **Notice!!!! Renewal Notices have been sent out !!!!**

There has been an important change in the membership categories. Military and Collegiate memberships no longer exist for the 2013 year. Members who are currently in one of those two categories will have to renew as a regular member and include the \$60.00 work bond fee which can be worked off. The total membership dues will be \$260.00. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.

**2013 Renewals:**

1. Please verify the dues amount is correct based on the type of membership that you have and remember to include the locker fee if it applicable.
2. Make sure that your NRA membership is current as of December 31, 2012
3. Sign the form at the bottom of the page.
4. Mail the renewal form and payment to the address at the top of the form or, place the form and the payment in an envelope and put it in the slot on the door of the safe at the Club.
5. **Deadline for membership renewal is December 31, 2012.** Renewals received after the deadline will be assessed a late fee of one-half their membership fee.

**NRA Membership Reminder** If your NRA membership is about to expire please renew it. All MEMBERS MUST BE NRA MEMBERS. This is necessary to ensure compliance for legal and insurance purposes. This will make renewing the Club membership at the end of the year a lot easier. If your NRA membership has expired your Club membership renewal cannot be processed.

**Do you want to continue loading more than one round?** The Board made a rule change pertaining to shooting in the rifle tube. A member may now load up to 10 rounds in the magazine of their rifle. The rest of the rule still applies. **Shoot one, Spot one.** This is a temporary rule change and will be in effect until January 1, 2013 at which time damage to the tube will be assessed. **Extension of the rule will depend on the amount of damage that has occurred.** Many members have expressed their approval of this change. If you want the rule to continue beyond the first of the year, members using the tube must be more careful and ensure that their rounds are on target. Please shoot responsibly and encourage others to do so also.

**TUBE NEWS:** From Alan Montoya. Three members were qualified in the tube. Damage to the tube recently has not been as bad as in the past. Please continue to verify that the impact of the round is on target before firing the next round.

**CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB GENERAL MEETING MINUTES**

**September 14, 2012**

The general membership meeting for the month of September, 2012 was held as scheduled on September 14, 2012 at the club house.

Present: Jim Bailey; Jack Orischak; Lee Eihausen; Warren Johnston; Alan Montoya; Gary Trisdale; Tom DeHerrera; and Joe Lima.

Not Present: Jim Enos; Jack Priest; Jack Johansen; and Clark Calve

President Jim Bailey called the meeting to order at 1900 followed by the pledge of allegiance.

**Comments by Club Members:** There were no comments from the floor.

**BOARD MEMBER REPORTS:**

1. Mr. Allan Montoya reported that there were two qualifications performed in the tube last month and if anyone was interested in signing up to please do so for the next scheduled qualification. If no one signs up he will not plan to be there. Someone put a hole in one of the light plates down range in the tube.
2. Mr. Lee Eihausen reported the following expenses for the Club this month: Excel bill for last month was \$1,541.00; Century Link \$62.00; Waste Management \$78.00; Comcast \$99.00; water \$97.00; and NRA liability insurance \$3923.00.  
Guest Fees for August totaled \$85.00.
3. Mr. Gary Trisdale reported several new junior shooters. One is the son of a former Junior.
4. Mr. Jack Orischak reported that the irrigation system has been completed thanks in no small part to the hard work of Kim Duleff.
5. Tom DeHerrera reported that two of the spotting scopes in the tube need some repair. He will look into the cost of repair versus replacement. A member of the Club can get new scopes at a deep discount. Tom said that some of the members that smoke would like to consider erecting a shelter of some kind to be used during inclement weather. There was no discussion of the topic.
6. Warren Johnston said there would be a work party Saturday the 15<sup>th</sup>.
7. Joe Lima reported that the renewal forms and envelopes have been printed and are ready to be mailed later this month.

Report on Committees: A member of the nominating committee reported that there has been little response for applicants to run for the Board.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Mike Thomas a relative newer member of the Club, recognizing the need for a functioning website stepped up and created a new one. He gave a brief review of the site and informed the members present that it is a work in progress and asked fellow members to provide input for its content. He is particularly interested in the history of the Club. Any members with historical information should contact any Board member. The Club thanked Mike for the work he has done in getting the website up and running.

**Unfinished Business:** No unfinished Business was brought up.

1. Jim Bailey read the applications for membership. The applicants talked of their interest in the club, and their experience with firearms and the sport of hunting. There were 5 new member applicants: Jeffrey Diehl; Richard Gleason; Jason Kelly; Pierre Norman; and Randy Wittmer. All potential members told a little about themselves and were excused to the pistol range area. One of the members spoke on behalf of the applicant they were sponsoring. A vote was taken by the attending membership and all were accepted to the club. Our new members were asked to rejoin the general meeting and welcomed to the club. It was explained to them that there would be a pistol range orientation right after the general membership meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 1935.

The meeting was called to order by President Jim Bailey at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

**Absent:** All members were in attendance.

There were no comments from the floor:

**The Board of Directors report:**

1. Jack Orischak reported that the irrigation system is complete. Twelve more mature trees were purchased and planted. No club money was used for the purchase of the trees. He also pointed out that there have yet to be any signs posted with the regulations for using carbines on the pistol range.
2. Lee Eihausen bundled the internet, voice, and basic cable with Comcast and was able to save the Club about \$15.00 a month.
3. Alan Montoya reported three members qualified in the tube and that in the last couple of weeks the damage to the tube has been much less.
4. Gary Trisdale informed us that the Juniors were doing well and there were a couple of new members
5. Jack Johansen said he has recruited a couple of new members.
6. Joe Lima reported the renewals have been mailed. Members should note the deadline for renewals and that they must have a current NRA membership
7. Clark reported that the fire extinguishers had been recertified by a member who does not charge the Club for the service.
8. Tom DeHerrera reported that he is still researching the repair/purchase of a couple of spotting scopes for the tube.
9. Jim Bailey reported there has been some interest in Hunter Safety Classes, but it might be too late to schedule anything this year.
10. Warren Johnston reported the November Work Party will be held on the 10<sup>th</sup> instead of the 17<sup>th</sup> to accommodate the 2700 Match that will be held on the 17<sup>th</sup>.

**Unfinished Business:** A question concerning outside video surveillance was brought up. Jim Bailey indicated that the present video system is working and there are no immediate plans to make any new purchases. Cameras and equipment will be upgraded when needed.

**New Business:**

1. Chuck Towne reported that he has inspected the target carriers and they are functioning properly. He has also been in contact with Fred Crowle the former Club historian and will be gathering historical information about the Club so that it can be added to the Club website.
2. Jack Orischak presented a motion to confer Kim Duleff with a Life Membership. Listing a number of projects that Kim has been involved in during his 14 years of membership. The most recent being the reconstruction of the irrigation system and the planting of the shrubs and trees. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.
3. A motion was made to start the Winter Bullseye league the 22<sup>nd</sup> of October. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

A motion was made to adjourn. It was seconded and passed.
