1. The President called the meeting to order at 7:02 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.
2. Lee Eihausen reported receiving \$334 in guest fees. He has received approximately 100 renewals and there is about \$35,000 in the checking account.
3. Al Montoya reported qualifying one member in the use of the rifle tube.
4. Tom DeHerrera said that the rifle tube looks ok.
5. Mike Thomas reported that there are approximately 600 members in the club and that 124 have renewed. Three members have resigned and there are many members who are not current NRA members. Renewal notices will be returned if you are not a current NRA member. Jack Orischak suggested that a "potshot" be sent to members.
6. Bill Spinuzzi is working on holding the air matches and also realigning the video system cameras.
7. Jim Schwartz has donated a tool box for the shed per Tom DeHerrera.
8. Jim Bailey read a letter from Larry Aughenbaugh who requests inactive status due to a move.
9. Jack Orischak is trying to get the accounting system set up but is not getting timely support from the club's previous CPA. Jack said that he has still not received an accounting for the last several months from the previous accountant. A new PC and software has been purchased for the new accountants. The club has received very few requests for work bond refunds.
10. Gary Trisdale said that the accountants will need financial statements from the activities chairmen for the information needed for the IRS report.

11. Al Montoya suggested that a defibrillator be purchased through member Joe Anderson for \$1395. The unit is a Heart Sign Samaritan. A motion was made to purchase the unit which passed unanimously.

12. Bill Spinuzzi said that the realignment of the video system will monitor the keeping of the defibrillator.

14. The meeting was adjourned at 7:27 PM.
