GOOD TO KNOW!

When I had my gangrene gallbladder taken out and spent 10 days in the hospital for what should have been an overnight stay the insurance company kicked me out. I had home nurse visits for two weeks and was asked if I had guns in the house. I respond that if I did I would not tell them. So the below has some merit. FYI, I am passing this along. There are comments from two other people I have also been asked if we keep guns in the house. The nurse just kinda slipped it in along with all the other regular questions. I told her I refused to answer because it was against the law to ask. Everyone whether you have guns or not, should give a neutral answer so they have no idea who does and who doesn't. My doctor asked me if I had guns in my house and also if any were loaded. I, of course, answered yes to both questions. Then he asked why I kept a loaded gun close to my bed. I answered that my son, who is a certified gun instructor and also works for Homeland Security, advised me that an unloaded, locked up gun is no protection against criminal attack.

The Government now requires these questions be asked of people on Medicare, and probably everyone else.

Just passing this along for your information: I had to visit a doctor other than my regular doctor when my doctor was on vacation. One of the questions on the form I had to fill out was: Do you have any guns in your house?? My answer was None of your damn business!!

So it is out there! It is either an insurance issue or government intervention. Either way, it is out there or the second the government gets into your medical records (as they want to under Obamacare) it will become a major issue and will ultimately result in lock and load!!

Please pass this on to all the other retired guys and gun owners. Thanks, from a Vietnam Vet and retired Police Officer:

I had a doctor's appointment at the local VA clinic yesterday and found out something very interesting that I would like to pass along.

While going through triage before seeing the doctor, I was asked at the end of the exam, three questions: 1. Did I feel stressed? 2. Did I feel threatened? 3. Did I feel like doing harm to someone?

The nurse then informed me that if I had answered yes to any of the questions I would have lost my concealed carry permit as it would have gone into my medical records and the VA would have reported it to Homeland Security.

Looks like they are going after the vets first. Other gun people like retired law enforcement will probably be next. Then when they go after the civilians, what argument will they have? Be forewarned and be aware. The Obama administration has gone on record

as considering veterans and gun owners potential terrorists. **Whether you are a gun owner, veteran or not, YOU'VE BEEN WARNED !**

If you know veterans and gun owners, please pass this on to them. Be very cautious about what you say and to whom.

CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

December 14, 2012

The general membership meeting for the month of December, 2012 was held as scheduled on December 14, 2012 at the club house.

The meeting was called to order by President Jim Bailey at 0700 followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

A minute of silence was observed for the innocent victims of the Newtown, CT murders.

Comments by Club Members: There were no comments from the floor.

BOARD MEMBER REPORTS:

1. Alan Montoya: Next tube qualification will be January 18th. There have been an unusual number of holes in the tube the past couple of weeks. New membership categories go into effect starting January 1st. They are Regular, Associate, and Junior. Junior membership will be assessed at 20% of the regular membership.
2. Lee Eihausen: reported \$290.00 and \$130.00 guest fees for the last couple of weeks. The club has about \$70,000 in the bank.
3. Jack Orischak: No comment.
4. Tom DeHerrera: reported that the bid for installation of new carpet came in at \$5000. It was rejected as too expensive.
5. Joe Lima: reported that about 311 members have renewed for next year. The revisions to the Member's book have been uploaded to the website. The chronological history of the Club compiled by Chuck Towne has also been posted to the website.
6. Clark Calve: No comment.
7. Gary Trisdale: reported the juniors were doing well and one did very well at the recent match held at the Olympic Training Center. The small bore shooting is going well.
8. Jack Johansen: No comment.

NEW BUSINESS: Inactive status was granted to a member whose job will take him out of state for most of 2013. Another member asked that his daughter's membership not be considered until after the 1st of the year. That request was also granted.

A member asked about the possibility of various types of classes being taught at the Club. He was reminded that it is Club policy not to allow instructors to be paid for classes that they teach.

A member asked about the feasibility of erecting dividers between the lanes on the pistol range. Most felt it would be too expensive and not necessary.

Unfinished Business: No unfinished Business was brought up.

1. Jim Bailey read the applications for membership. The applicants talked of their interest in the club, and their experience with firearms and the sport of hunting. There were 10 new member applicants: Harry Brown; Jeffrey Brotherston; David Hedrick; Lynette Lee; Steven Lee; Phillip Mizuno; Wendy Mizuno; Maria Otero-Brotherston; Jim Stewart; and Martin Tritschler. The potential members told a little about themselves and were excused to the pistol range area. A vote was taken by the attending membership and they were accepted as members. Since there were only 12 candidates a vote by acclamation was made and all were duly elected.

CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB BOD MEETING MINUTES

December 28, 2012

The meeting was called to order by President Jim Bailey at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

Comments from the Floor: Bill B. voiced concerns about the placement of the new spotting scopes, indicating that a shooter must get up from the shooting position to spot the hit on the target, this disrupts the natural order of the universe if the shooter is trying out new loads are different bullets as is often the case. He requested that the spotting scopes be more ergonomically mounted.

The Board of Directors report:

1. Jack Orischak: No comment.
2. Lee Eihausen: The Club collected nearly \$500.00 in guest fees this past month.
3. Gary Trisdale: The Juniors have had a very successful year.
4. Jack Johansen No comments.
5. Joe Lima: Reported 420 members have renewed, leaving about 123 yet to do so.
6. Clark Calve: No comments
7. Tom DeHerrera: Addressed Bill's concern about the scopes and indicated a solution is forth coming. He also asks that members using the tube treat them carefully.
8. Warren Johnston: Reminded everyone that the January Work Party is scheduled for the 19th. But Clark Calve, who will be assuming Warren's duties as Work Party coordinator, said that there would not be a January work party. Future work party dates are currently tentative.
9. Alan Montoya: Reported that he is working on brackets that will allow the spotting scopes in the tube to be positioned in a more favorable position.
10. Jim Bailey announced the installation of the BOD for 2013.

Unfinished Business: Tom Rodriquez thanked the 2012 BOD for its help in providing the documentation necessary to complete the IRS audit. Because it was successfully completed and considered closed out there should be no further action from the IRS and the Club will not lose its current tax status.
