CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

February 8, 2013

The first combined General Membership Meeting/Board of Directors Meeting was held as scheduled on February 8, 2013 at the club house.

The meeting was called to order by President Jim Bailey at 1900 followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Not Present: Dave Epps, Gary Trisdale

Comments by Club Members: There were no comments from the floor.

Presentation of any Guests:

Tony Fabian from the Colorado State Shooting Association was the guest speaker. Explained the pending bills before the Colo. legislature, and the Denver city Govt. There were 51 people in attendance, a very high turnout for any club meeting. Tony stressed the importance of all concerned gun owners to WRITE to our elected representatives. The recommendation is to ask directly how our reps. will vote on the bills being presented, indicating our voting support for those who support gun rights and our objection to ANY restrictions of firearm ownership, possession, transfer or any other further restrictions of the right to bear arms. He spoke for 20 minutes, then took questions for 20 minutes. An enthusiastic audience of 51 people greatly appreciated his presentation. BOARD MEMBER REPORTS:

1. Jim Bailey: Nothing to Report.
2. Alan Montoya: reported the diffusers are missing from the chronograph in the rifle tube. Maybe someone took them home to clean them so the chronograph connections work like new again? Alan replaced them, and the wiring that was shot is being repaired. They should be completed by Feb. 13 th.
Alan also pointed out that the qualification of new shooters for access to the rifle tube will require either a sighted in scope or iron sights. Dot sights on a rifle will not be permitted.
3. Lee Eihausen: Treasurer reported a utility bill of \$3273.45 for the month of January.
4. Jack Orischak: Members are asked to turn on only the lights you need over your shooting lane.

Having every light on in the pistol range when you are the only one shooting will probably result in someone who IS concerned about the \$3200 utility expense coming in and turning a bunch of them off. WE ALL pay the bills here. Be considerate. The DUES can be increased if necessary to cover growing expenses. Most would prefer them not to be.

Mention was made of the brass in the blue barrels.

Yes, you can get some for your personal reloading. But do not abuse this privilege.

Taking a 5 gallon bucket is NOT allowed. Be considerate. Don't steal. The brass and lead is sold and the proceeds go to the Junior program to offset some of their expenses. Members caught in violation will risk having their membership suspended or revoked.

CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB BOD MEETING MINUTES
February 8, 2013

After a brief recess the BOD meeting was called to order by President Jim Bailey at 8:50 PM.

In attendance: Lee Eihausen; Clark Calve; Glenn Walls; Jack Priest; Alan Montoya; Denise Henry; Jim Bailey; and Jack Orischak; Tom Sweetser was excused for medical reasons. We wish him a speedy recovery, and hope he returns soon.

Absent: Tom Deherrera; Gary Trisdale; and Dave Epps.

Comments: Last month a motion to combine the General and BOD meetings to one night a month was made and passed. This meeting was the first under the new proposal. Some members wanted to revisit the proposed change. It was discussed and decided to continue combining the two meetings on the second Friday of the month with a half hour recess between the two meetings.

New Business: Mike Thomas, webmaster requested that a member roster and contact information be published on the Club Website. After discussion, it was defeated, 6 opposed, and 2 abstaining. It was decided member privacy overrode other advantages. We thank Mike for bringing this forward.

Unfinished Business: Two motions that involved Bylaw changes were brought to the floor for vote. One involved the collection of membership dues; the other involved the number of Board members. Bylaw changes require a notice to the BOD of at least 10 days prior to voting.

The First changed the method of collecting membership dues by new applicants. The application fee which is non-refundable will be collected at the time the person applies for membership. The actual membership fee will not be collected until the applicant attends a monthly meeting and is voted into the Club.

The Second involved a motion to reduce the number of members required for the BOD. A motion to elect 7 members to the BOD effective 2014 was defeated.

A Bylaw motion proposing the BOD be reduced from 13 members to 9 members was introduced at the BOD meeting of Jan 25, 2013. The proposal was e mailed to all BOD members on Jan. 26, 2013. The motion was discussed and passed, 6 in favor, 1 opposed. The Bylaw change will be effective with the BOD elected for the 2014 year.

Motion to Adjourn: A motion was made to adjourn. It was seconded and passed. The meeting was adjourned at 9:10 P.M.
