From the Safety Officer

The red steel panels above the hard plate steel backstop and target carrier rails are suffering increasingly serious damage by shooters who are either careless, dumb or just plain malicious. Members are acting irresponsibly on their own or are not properly supervising their guests. (Remember one hot gun on the line at a time when you have guests)

We cannot allow this sort of damage to continue. Accordingly, as a test program, I have made up longer sticks to be used for target hangers. Although you are not required to use those sticks, we would appreciate you using them in order to be able to measure, with consistency, the mitigation of damage caused by carelessness.

If you must use your own stick, please replace the long stick in its holder when you leave. We realize this test will increase the number of hits on the floor, but it looks like many folks are already doing that and it is not causing anywhere near the damage being done to our target carriers and red panels.

- 1. The meeting was called to order by the President at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.**
- 2. Lee Eihausen reported receiving \$150 in guest fees and that there is approximately \$60,000 in the checking account.**
- 3. Jack Orischak said that Jack Priest was in the hospital following surgery.**
- 4. Tom DeHerrera said that he was working on the rifle tube target trying to get the target to stand vertical.**
- 5. Gary Trisdale reported that the Juniors attended a match at the OTC along with 150 other participants.**
- 6. Allen Montoya did not qualify anyone this period and that the defibulator has been purchased and is hanging on the wall next to the first aid box.**
- 7. Mike Thomas said the he has received half to two thirds of the renewal notices and that he has to resend some to members who lost them. He is not getting many corrections to the member's information.**

8. Jack Orischak remembered the value of a defibulator and first class held earlier.
9. Bill Spinuzzi asked whether a guest shooting the air matches need to sign the waiver form more than once. He will keep a file of the waiver forms.
10. Mike Thomas said that Sprouts has posted a sign saying that no firearms are allowed in their store. If you feel strongly about that, post your feelings on face book.
11. Jim Bailey introduced David Burch who is applying for membership. He was accepted into the club by unanimous vote.
12. Bill Spinuzzi said that there are nine candidates for the 2014 Board of Directors. There were no nominations from the floor. A motion to accept the candidates by acclimation passed unanimously. Those elected are Bailey, Buglovsky, Calve, DeHerrera, Dickson, Orischak, Priest, Thomas, and Trisdale.
13. Jim Bailey handed out certificates of merit for those leaving the Board. Those receiving the certificates are Lee Eihausen, Allan Montoya, Glenn Walls, Denise Henry and Chuck Towne.
14. The meeting was adjourned at 7:21 PM.

CHERRY CREEK GUN CLUB BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

December 27, 2013

Attendees: Bailey, Towne, Montoya, Thomas, Priest, DeHerrera, Eihausen, Orischak and Calve

The President called the meeting to order at 6:59 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.

2. Jack Orischak said that a member asked whether he could split his renewal fees and that he would be late paying his fees. Another member said that he would be late with his fees. Due to the lateness of getting the renewal notices out, the board extended the cutoff date to January 31, 2014.
3. The secretary received a call from Norm Steinhoff who is moving out of state and is resigning from the club.
4. Lee Eihausen reported \$30,000 in the checking account and that four refunds were overpaid.
5. Clark Calve reported that everything in the ranges, work. A crutch has been installed at 50 feet in the rifle tube.
6. Al Montoya reported qualifying one member in the use of the rifle tube and has received the results of background checks on three members.
7. Jack Orischak said that Pete Dickson was out of town and that Glenn Walls was ill.

8. Jack Orischak nominated John Buglovsky for Treasurer who was accepted by unanimous vote. In a like manner, Mike Thomas was elected Secretary, Jack Orischak, Vice President and Jim Bailey, President.

9. Jack Orischak said that the club still needs financial records. Lee Eihausen said that they have been received.

10. Tom DeHerrera volunteered to be caretaker of the rifle tube.

11. Mike Thomas suggested that Bill Spinuzzi maintain the membership data base. He was accepted to that position.

CORRECTION: Mike Thomas moved that Bill Spinuzzi take over the membership DUTIES previously done very capably by Alan Montoya. That would include membership forms, background checks, and entry records. Mike will continue to maintain the membership database.

12. Jim Bailey said that according to Robert's rules of order, a member who has the floor may not yield the floor to another; only the chair may transfer the floor to another.

13. Chuck Towne said that the range is looking more like a shooting gallery than a shooting range. He said that since there is no longer a work bond but now is called a maintenance fee, that there is approximately \$30,000 in the maintenance fee account. He suggested that some of that money be used to get the range painted and to repair items that need repair. Clark Calve said that it would like a gallery shortly as members don't seem to take care where their shots impact. A lengthy discussion followed.

14. Jack Orischak said that he has four members who are willing to help maintain the range.

15. It was reported that the meeting room temperature ranges between 60 and 80 degrees. Jack Priest asked to be on a committee to work on improving the temperature extreme spread.

16. Jim Bailey asked the status of the range energy audit. Jack Orischak said that there seemingly is no solution for improvement.

17. Bill Bierbach suggested that the club needs to present a nice looking range and that it should be painted more often to keep it looking nice.

18. Bill Spinuzzi suggested putting a video camera near the crutch to monitor for damage.

19. The meeting was adjourned at 7:37 PM.
